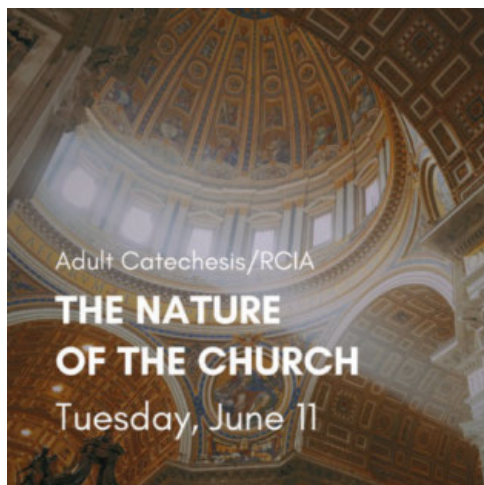
The Good Life is a FREE scripture study/catechism class held at St. Philip's throughout the year. It includes food & fellowship, prayer, discussion and lesson.

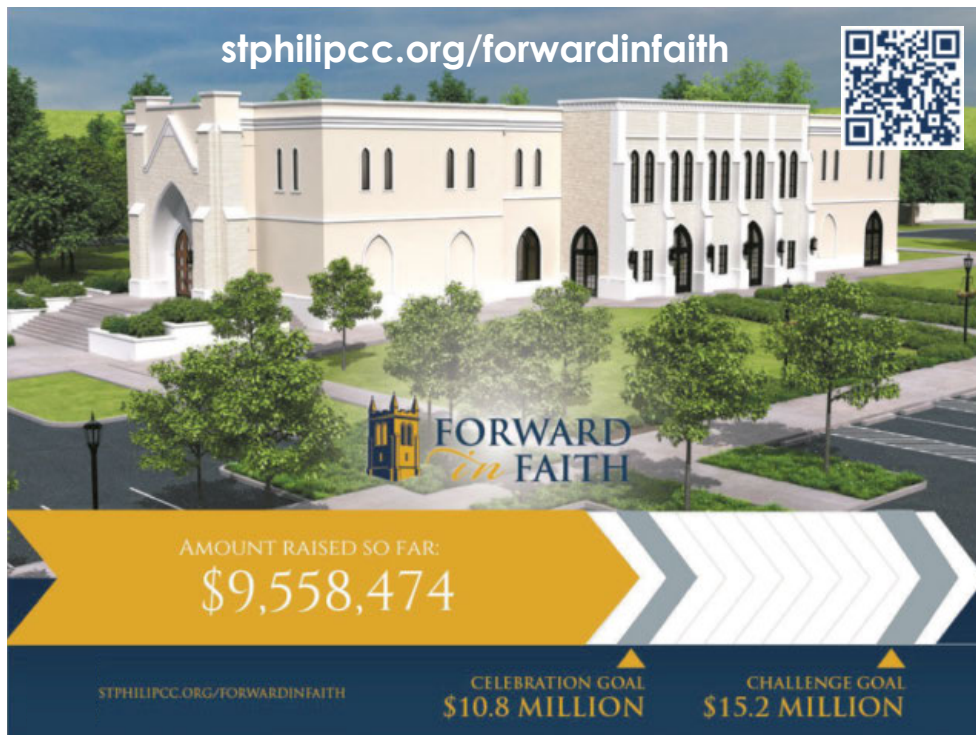


