



Kindergarten—1st Grade

Meets Tuesdays from 4:30-5:30 PM

For K-1, we offer a Parent/Child class to learn about, and help your child grow in, the Faith. Families are the Domestic Church, where all learning has taken place since birth. You chose the Catholic Faith for your child at Baptism, and have modeled your faith by praying and attending Mass with them. Now, before the sacrament year in 2nd grade, let us work with you and your child to continue their formation in the Catholic Faith.

First Penance/First Communion (2nd Grade)

Fall or Spring class options available; See dates for classes and First Communion Masses online at stphilipcc.org/first-communion
A student preparing for First Penance/First Communion must be baptized in the Catholic Church and be seven or older, usually in 2nd grade. Preparation for First Penance and First Communion is completed by children and parent(s) with a combination of a Parent Meeting, Home Study, and In-person Parent/Child classes.

3-5th Grade

Four class options available: Choose from Tuesdays 4:30-5:45 PM or 6:15-7:30 PM; Wednesdays from 5:15-6:30 PM or 7:15-8:30 PM. Over these three years, children study Salvation History, Prayer and Sacraments, and the Life of Christ. Classes reach all learning styles with games, videos, and activities so that students continue to grow in their faith and have community with other children.

Can You Serve in Elementary Formation?

3rd-5th Grade sessions require the help of a core group of adult and teen volunteers. Consider helping in the following roles:

Teachers (Catechists): Two teachers in each classroom are needed to teach a weekly lesson. Training and all materials are provided. The only requirements are being a practicing Catholic and having a love of the Catholic Faith.

Greeting Team: Be a friendly face to welcome children as they arrive for class; keep attendance, monitor restrooms, and help with clean-up. *Contact Kim Carr at kimc@stphilipcc.org to learn more.*



Steps Between

Milestones

The Sacraments are milestones in our lives and typically take place when we are an infant (Baptism), child (Confession/Communion), teen (Confirmation), and young adult (Marriage).

The steps between these milestones and beyond are critical to being fully formed in the Catholic Faith: Formation is both sacramental preparation and catechism classes.

St. Philip provides formation in the Catholic Faith at all points along this road. As you look forward to the next year, there may not be a sacramental "milestone" for your child in 2025, but the formation they receive in their Faith in this year is a crucial next step.

Middle School Youth Group (6-8th Grade)

Meets Wednesdays from 7:15-8:30 PM

MS Youth Group is a larger group which meets during the academic year. Each meeting consists of a lesson on faith/morals, some time to practice the Faith together (usually some kind of prayer), and a game. MS Youth Group is aimed at:

- Learning the faith at a deeper level than was possible in Elementary Formation & beginning to engage with more difficult topics of our times.
- Encouragement to holiness and personal practice of our Faith.
- Sparking holy friendships with other Catholic youth.

High School Formation Improvements for 2024/2025

In the coming 2024/2025 school year, you'll notice some changes in our High School Formation. While the familiar "large group" class format will still be available as an extra option, **High School students will receive their main formation through "Discipleship Groups."**

What is a Discipleship Group?

High School Discipleship Groups are smaller, more intentional formation settings in which groups of 4-8 young men or young women meet year-round for personally-tailored catechesis and spiritual growth. Each group has two adult mentors. The aims of Discipleship Groups are:

- Personalized guidance for each student on how to live a Catholic life in their particular circumstances
- · Accountability for spiritual progress and prayer life
- Deep, lasting friendships centered on the pursuit of holiness

In addition to their Discipleship Groups, Teens are encouraged to come to the HS Youth Group.

What is HS Youth Group?

HS Youth Group is a large group which meets during the academic year. Each meeting consists of either a conversation about a moral/religious topic that the high schoolers find interesting or a walkthrough/practice of the Faith (usually prayer), followed by a game. Students are encouraged to attend Youth Group meetings as an additional activity to the main track of formation they receive within Discipleship Groups.

Teen Bible Studies

Sessions for both Middle School and High School Teens

An additional option available to teens, Bible Studies are small, weekly, year-round meetings. Through study of the Scriptures, teens learn to unlock some of the infinite amount of treasure that our Lord has buried in the Scriptures for us to find; Who God is, what He has done for us, how He wishes us to pray, and how to view the world and reality.

Teens must be at least 15 years old or in the 10th grade to be eligible for HS Confirmation. Preparation consists of attending 8 classes, learning certain pious practices, and completing an end-of-session assessment.
