

Celebrate and Reverence God's Vision of Human Sexuality: Learn more about the beauty and gift of Natural Family Planning (NFP) as we celebrate the 56th Anniversary of the papal encyclical Humanae Vitae which articulates Catholic beliefs about human sexuality, conjugal love, and responsible parenthood.

NFP is a method learned by both husband and wife, which educates them in becoming aware of the body's physical indicators of fertility. NFP can be used to avoid and achieve pregnancy. NFP can be used in ANY cycle regardless of the woman's circumstances, including regular cycles, irregular cycles, breastfeeding, pre-menopause, or low fertility.

Before setting about their weekly cleaning of the church sanctuary, the members of the Saint Zita of Lucca ministry say a brief prayer to the Patron Saint of domestic workers. Throughout her life in the 13th century, St. Zita demonstrated a tireless, unwavering sprit of selfless service tethered to a deep and active commitment to her Catholic Faith.

Ministry crews dust and wipe down the pews and floor of the church, straighten the pockets in each pew, and replenish Mass cards. They also dust the choir loft railing and clean other areas as needed (e.g., erasing writing on church pillars). "I do the church prep cleaning because it is important to maintain the home of Christ and the Church," explains one ministry worker. Adds another, echoing St. Zita: "We like to be of service."

Ministry leader Susan Schabel shares the origin of the ministry's dedication to cleansing the Lord's house, and how they go about their important work: "We started by cleaning in preparation for Christmas and Easter and then cleaned after the organ installation. We then decided it would be better to do it on a regular basis. By having 4 teams, a person only has to commit to one Tuesday a month. They can be on multiple teams if they would like to be."

In addition to providing a worthwhile service to the parish, ministry members experience blessings themselves: "I would tell a friend how fun and rewarding this time is because we spend it with new and old friends and Jesus!" And here's a great reason for mothers to join the team: "If a mom has a preschooler, it's something they can do together: the child feels important and has something special to do with mom while the older siblings are in school."

Welcome Basket Supplies for

Catholic Charities FW Refugee Program

Families who are served by Catholic Charities' Refugee Program are often housed with very little notice, and have limited time and resources to be able to purchase household items. Our August Neighbor Days will be dedicated to collecting these items to be packed in the welcome baskets CCFW provides these families.

Who receives CCFW Welcome Baskets?

These baskets would be going to newly arrived refugee families from the countries of Afghanistan, Syria, Burma/Myanmar, The Democratic Republic of Congo (and other surrounding African countries), Venezuela, Guatemala, and Honduras. Many of these families come with only the clothes they have on and in hopes of a brighter future. They have suffered persecution in their home country, ultimately making the difficult choice to flee their homes and seek refugee in a neighboring country before being selected to resettle here in America. Some families have a wait of over a decade before being selected for a third country resettlement—and they don't get to choose which country. Having the opportunity to rebuild their life here in America is appreciated, but it can also be overwhelming. CCFW's Reception and Placement team prepares apartments for these families shortly before they arrive, and anything extra we can provide is always appreciated.
