

Fr. Gerard Mary is well known at St. Philip from the occasions when he has served our parish; he is also the founder of the Divine Face Organization, a mission dedicated to serving the poorest of the poor in his native Nigeria. Please join us in thanking Father for his 50 years of priestly ministry!

Baptized Gerard Majella Akannamdi Anyanwu, Father was an early vocation; at just four years old, he had already made a decision to become a priest, and entered the seminary after elementary school. It was during this time that a young Gerard began to invoke Our Lady's help and aid under the title of "Mother of Special Graces." Years later, Father made his Consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary and officially changed his name to Gerard Mary A. Anyanwu.

Mission of the Divine Face Organization


Following his ordination on April 21, 1974, Father was sent to Rome, where he completed a doctorate in Classical Studies. He spent some time teaching, before entering parish work. All the while, he was seeking a way to promote devotion to Our Mother of Special Graces, and discovered it in service to the poor. Father realized that the only way to break the chain of poverty was through education, and so in August 1992, Father founded the Divine Face Organization with the goal of creating a school. To raise funds for the new school, Father conducted mission appeals in North Texas parishes, and founded the Divine Face Organization (DFO) in the USA. He also met the late Fr. Allan Hawkins, who gave DFO a very good home and support at St. Mary the Virgin.

Construction of some very humble housing for the poor and the nursery/elementary school of Our Mother of Special Graces began in October 1994. Through the generosity of donors, Father has since added a secondary school with dorms, and a chapel. The school gives scholarships

to the poor and provides the best education in the area. They also feed those in need.

In 2013, the parishioners of St. Philip the Apostle provided the funds for a new Vocational Building, and soon after, our parish began to host meetings and activities for the Divine Face Organization. St. Philip's continues to support DFO in a special way to this day.

Fr. Gerard Mary retired in 2021 and can now focus solely on the school and the religious community he has also founded, called the Stewards of Divine Face Harmony (Father is pictured at right with some of the members). This growing community has 8 young men at different stages of formation, and is also supported by the mission of the Divine Face Organization.

Guadalupe Radio Enhances Fort Worth-area Signal

Guadalupe Radio now has enhanced its signal in the greater Fort Worth area with programming via **newly acquired radio stations KHFX 1140 AM and 101.5 FM.** The new stations complement Guadalupe's 910 AM station based in Irving. The stations are broadcasting the same programming that is heard on Guadalupe 910 AM, and plans call for adding Fort Worth area news to the two news stations. Guadalupe Radio's stated mission is "to serve the Church" and "endeavor to lead souls back to Jesus Christ through His Holy Catholic Church, using the powerful means of radio and digital media."

The Guadalupe Radio Network operates 48 radio stations and reaches a population of 30 million potential listeners. It is the only Catholic radio organization establishing both Spanish and English Catholic radio stations in the same markets.




