## A Year in Review

### Our parish continues to grow

**St. Philip added over 200 registered families** during this fiscal year; our total number of registered families is now over 4,100.

**86 babies were baptized this year**, and an additional **69 children and adults were received into full communion** with the Church.

**21 marriages** were celebrated at St. Philip this year.

### Stained-glass windows coming to St. Philip

Last fall, St. Philip's obtained a rare set of 14 antique Mayer windows, matching the size specifications of our church. Fundraising for the restoration of these windows has rapidly progressed; of the 10 windows designated for the Phase I church, 9 have already been donated! Restoration work is now in progress, and the first window, depicting the Nativity, will be installed in time for Christmas. Windows are being restored one at a time; as each individual window is complete, it will take its place in our church. Watch for more updates about this exciting project coming soon.

### Forward in Faith

**In April 2023, the Forward in Faith Capital Campaign was launched** with a total goal of \$15.2 million to retire

Phase I construction debt, expand our parking, and build a new parish life center. The campaign has been a tremendous success already, raising \$9.5 million in record time and allowing us to repay our Phase I debt early and with no interest accrued.

Plans for the new building are close to completion, and we are now in the process of obtaining approvals from the Town of Flower Mound.

**To break ground on the new building, we need to raise at least \$10.8 million of our goal.** Plans are now in progress to launch our final push giving campaign—watch for more details!

### Thank you for supporting St. Philip

**Through your generosity, this year's revenue exceeded our budget by \$71,781.** While contributions were slightly below an ambitious target, other areas more than made up the difference, including donations to parish activities (social outreach, candles and flowers, and sponsorships of parish events).

Through this year, St. Philip continued to carefully manage our expense budget, **resulting in an overall cost savings of \$121,758.**

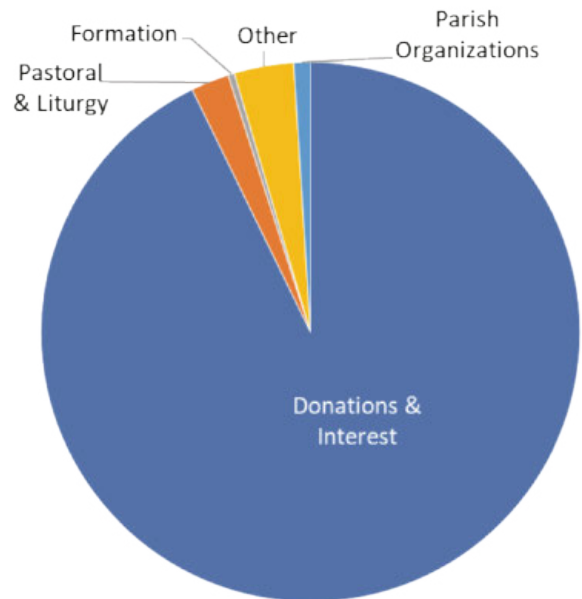

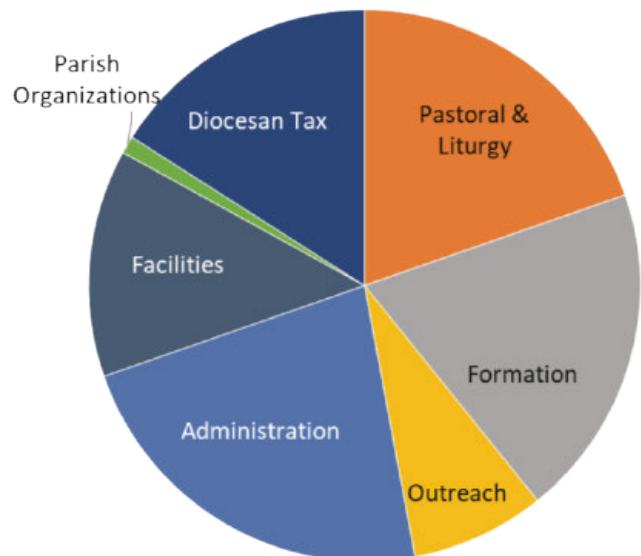

## Parish Debt

### Phase I Construction Debt was paid off as of February 2024.

On the second anniversary of our Church's Dedication we ceremonially burned our remaining \$2.6 million mortgage. Our parish's generosity and the success of our Forward in Faith campaign allowed us to pay off our debt before any interest accrued, **saving our parish \$332,000 in interest expense.**

### Land Debt: \$4.5 million

As is customary in the Diocese of Fort Worth, our Diocese purchased the land for our new campus with the expectation that our parish would ultimately repay the amount. The land investment has been an interest-free loan since 2015. Our parish will begin repaying the Diocese in 2027.



## PARISH REPORT: A YEAR IN REVIEW

### Expanding Our Outreach

**St. Philip increasingly engaged in volunteer and donation activities during the past year:**

- **Neighbor Days**, our project to collect food and supplies for local needs, expanded to serve a variety of community organizations, including Love Thy Neighbor and Sleep in Heavenly Peace.
- Parishioners donated supplies and prepared monthly sack lunches for Our Daily Bread homeless shelter and snack bags for Catholic Charities Fort Worth's Refugee School Impact Program. **We continue to provide about 350 sack lunches and approximately 50 snack bags each month.**
- Parish volunteers provided a **monthly dinner through the Breaking Bread program** for the working poor and homeless.
- **Laundry Love** assisted individuals and families in need through funding laundry expenses at a local laundromat.
- St. Philip volunteers served monthly as **cashiers at the CCA food pantry** to provide a welcoming and dignity-filled experience.
- **Special Projects volunteers** served the community at various organizations, including Heart of the City, Love thy Neighbor, Miracle League of North Texas, CCA, Our Daily Bread, and Magnolia Assisted Living Facility.
- **The Summer Lunch Program** continued our commitment to helping local children in need by participating in CCA's Kids Eat Free and Salvation Army's summer lunch programs.
- **Giving Tree, our Christmas outreach drive**, added the families served by Loreto House, our own Diocesan Seminarians, and some of our Diocesan rural parishes to our list of gift recipients.

### New Outreach Initiative:

#### Parishioners Helping Parishioners

In the near future, we will begin an initiative for our parishioners in the pews, helping meet needs close to home, large and small, such as a meal train, yard assistance, or incidental needs that require a helping hand. Together, we can lighten the heavy loads we sometimes carry, while pursuing holiness and love of neighbor.

### St. Vincent de Paul: The New Front Line of St. Philip Outreach

During the past year, a conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul has been established at St. Philip. Comprised of parishioner volunteers, the newly-formed conference has now taken on the role of providing emergency assistance to those in need.

**Unlike other social service agencies**, our Vincentians are available to respond to the many calls and situations we receive by bringing the love and hope of the Church to others when it matters most. Central to their mission is the Home Visit, where they meet directly with the person or family. They offer an environment of confidentiality, compassion and grace to those who seek our help.
