### A Building for Our Future

The photo above was taken during this year's Catholic Camp, one of the formation programs we regularly offer for children. Every year, this program attracts large numbers, more than our limited facilities can accept, and we have to turn kids away. This is just one instance where our new Parish Hall will allow St. Philip's to continue growing.

As we take the next step beyond our new church, **the Parish Hall will offer the welcoming and accessible spaces we lack** for parish families to connect with one another in faith and fellowship. Large classrooms on the second floor will better support and serve continued growth and participation in our faith formation programs for children and adults, as well as group studies and ministries that currently struggle to find room.

**Expansions to our parking lot** will support the new building, as well as provide additional handicap accessible spaces.

## FINAL PUSH TO GROUNDBREAKING

Today marks an important step in our campaign: we are at a crucial stage in our fundraising, just \$1.3 million away from our Challenge Goal. **Reaching this \$10.8 million milestone allows us to begin construction of the new Parish Hall and parking expansion.**

After over a year of hard work and sacrifice by our community, we've raised 88% of our goal! We owe a huge debt of gratitude to the many parishioners who have stepped up with extreme generosity to this point.

This incredible progress has been accomplished with the participation of only 20% of our parish families. **Imagine what we could do if every family decided to do something?**

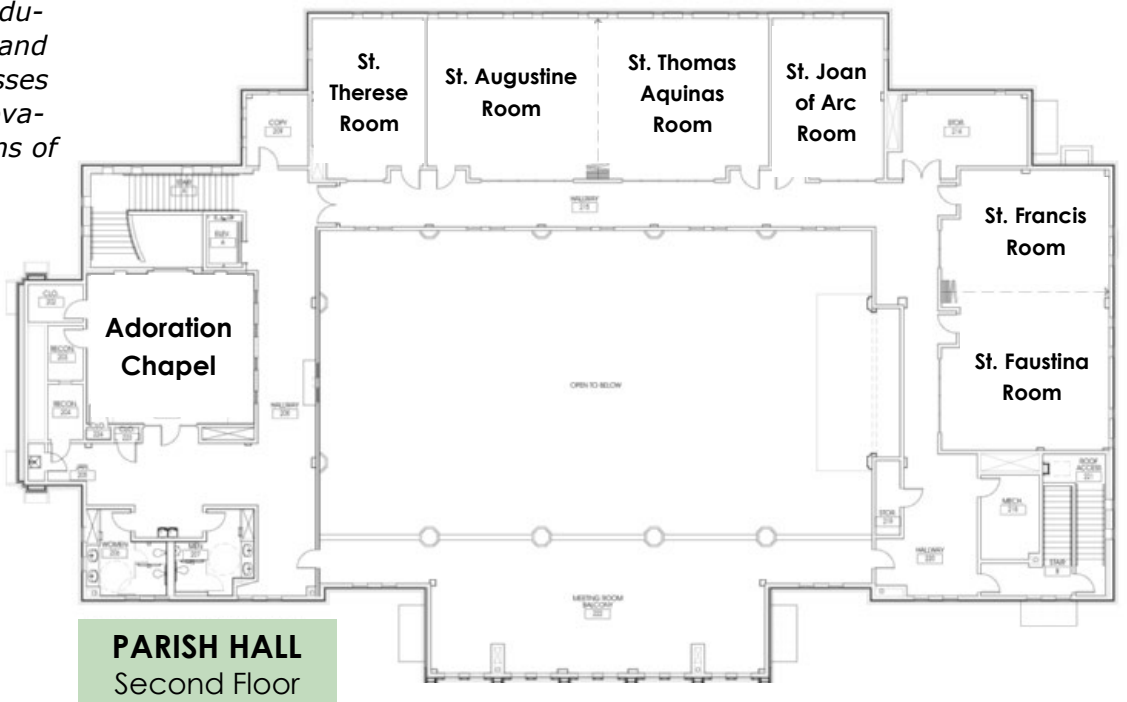
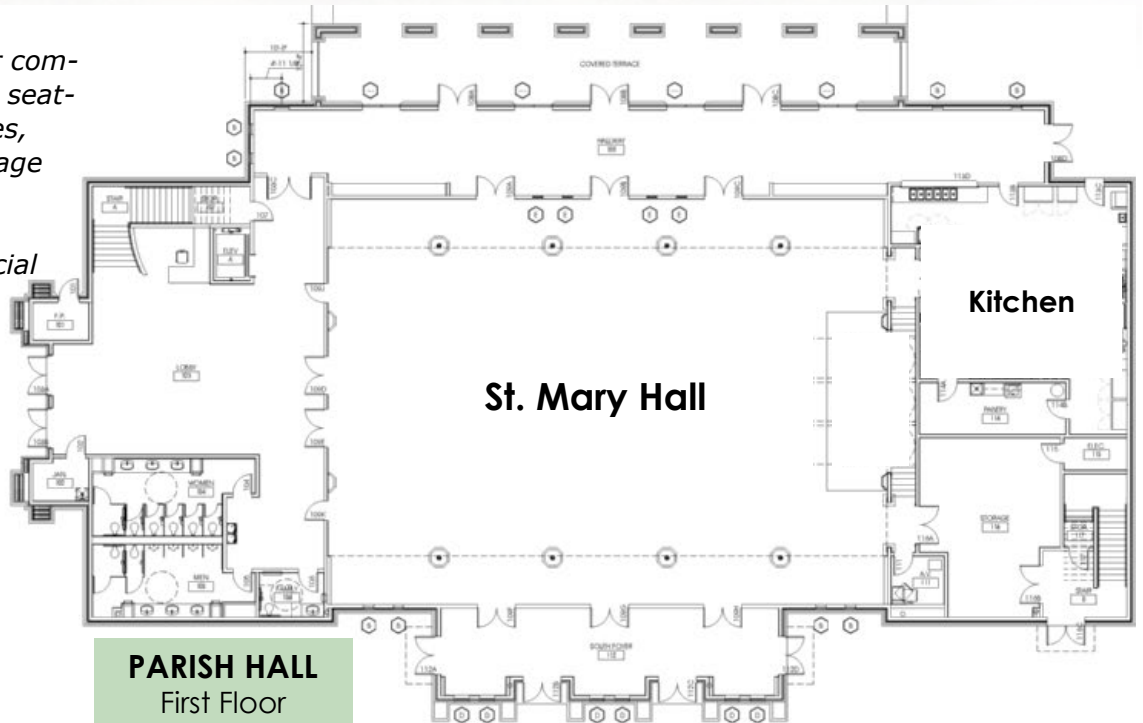


