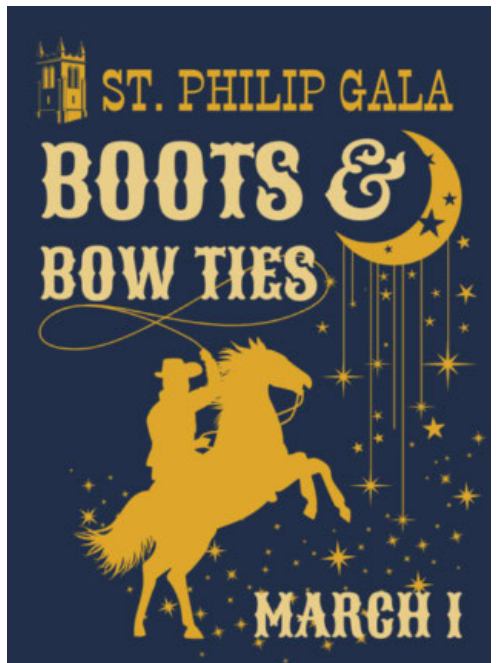

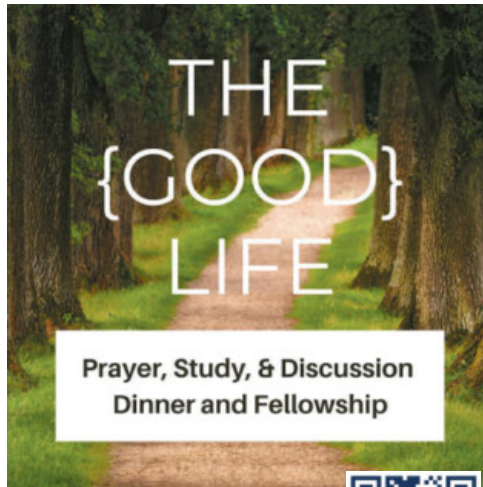


Adult Formation: The Good Life

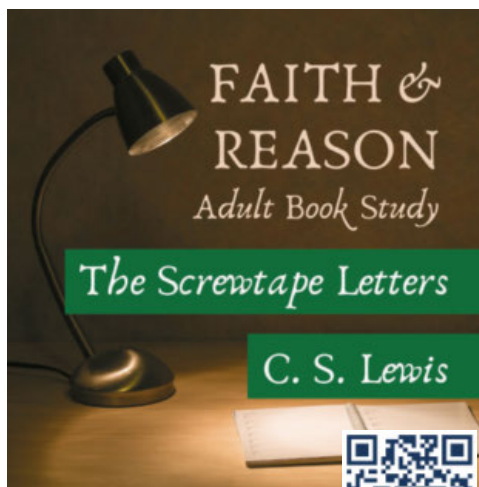
Faith & Reason Adult Book Study


