What is an Indulgence?

"An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints...An indulgence is partial or plenary according as it removes either part or all of the temporal punishment due to sin...The faithful can gain indulgences for themselves or apply them to the dead" (CCC 1471).

How to Gain Indulgences

To gain a **partial indulgence**, one must be a Catholic in a state of grace and perform the act to which the indulgence is attached with a contrite heart. To gain a **plenary (or total) indulgence**:

- Perform the act (such as one of those described here) while in a state of grace and with the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin (even venial sin)
- Make a sacramental Confession
- Receive Holy Communion
- Pray for the Pope's intentions (*one Our Father and one Hail Mary is customary*)

In order to be granted the indulgence, it is permissible to go to Confession and receive Holy Communion within 20 days of the act; however, it is preferred that this be done on the same day as the act. One sacramental Confession suffices for several plenary indulgences, but a separate Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the Holy Father's intentions are required for each plenary indulgence.



We are excited to announce that Bishop Michael Olson has established St. Philip the Apostle as one of the five pilgrimage sites in our Diocese for the Ordinary Jubilee Year called by Pope Francis. **These special sites are places where the Faithful may obtain the special grace of a plenary indulgence during the Jubilee year** by performing devout and pious acts, in addition to the usual conditions attached to an indulgence (see left).

The five parishes in our Diocese where one may journey to gain the Jubilee indulgence are:

*St. Patrick Cathedral, Fort Worth
Immaculate Conception Parish, Wichita Falls
Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish, Fort Worth
St. Philip Parish, Flower Mound
Sacred Heart Parish, Comanche*

How do I Gain a Jubilee Indulgence?

Make a Pilgrimage or Pious Visit to a Jubilee Site and participate in Mass or another of the devotions listed below:

"The faithful, *pilgrims of hope*, will be able to obtain the Jubilee Indulgence granted by the Holy Father if they undertake a pious pilgrimage: *to any sacred Jubilee site*: by devoutly participating in Holy Mass (...); a ritual Mass for the conferral of the sacraments of Christian Initiation or the Anointing of the Sick; or any of the following: a celebration of the Word of God; the Liturgy of the Hours (office of readings, lauds, vespers); the Via Crucis; the Marian Rosary; the recitation of the Akathist hymn; a penitential celebration, which ends with the individual confessions of the penitents, as established in the Rite of Penance...

Likewise, the faithful can obtain the Jubilee Indulgence if, individually or in a group, they devoutly visit any Jubilee site and there, for a suitable period of time, engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation, concluding with the Our Father, the Profession of Faith in any legitimate form, and invocations to Mary, the Mother of God, so that in this Holy Year everyone 'will come to know the closeness of Mary, the most affectionate of mothers, who never abandons her children' (*Spes non confundit*, 24)."

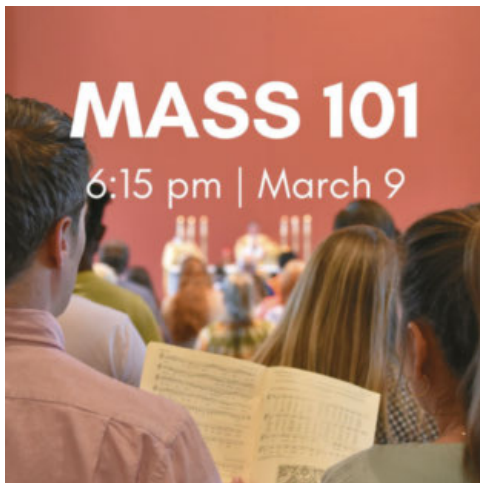

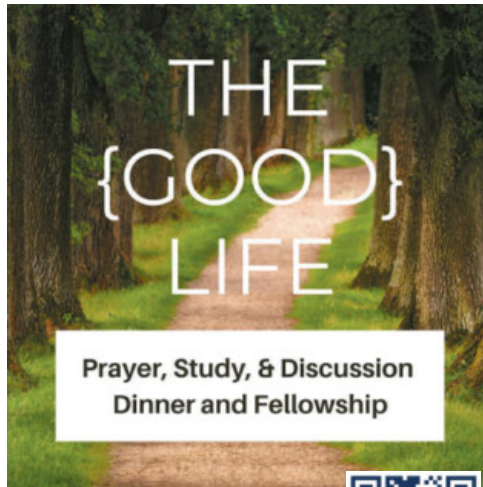

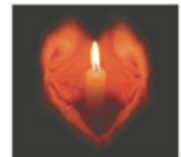

The Vatican II document on the liturgy, *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, defines the purpose of sacred music as "the glory of God and the sanctification of the faithful." Thus, according to Director Dr. Katie Schmitz, "the aim of the St. Philip Music Ministry is to offer our best to God and to elevate the soul. This is accomplished through following the guidelines of the Church regarding sacred music, educating ourselves, practicing, and cultivating our art."

Katie thoughtfully continues: "Sacred music forms a necessary or integral part of the solemn liturgy, which is why such deference is given to music. The musical tradition of the universal Church is a treasure of inestimable value. Thus, part of our vision is to dig into this treasury and explore the heritage of sacred music the Church has given us, as well as to explore newer resources such as English chant antiphons and modern sacred choral music."

The Music Ministry boasts two beautiful expressions of God's sacred music: the Children's Choir, open to children in Grades 3-8, and the St. Cecilia Choir, which is open to high-schoolers and adults. Parishioners can find additional opportunities to serve as musicians, cantors, and instrumentalists for Masses.

Even as they bless our parish with their God-given musical talents, ministry members, in turn, receive an abundance of blessings. High School Senior and Cantor Renee Lenski shares that "being a cantor has helped me strengthen my Catholic faith by deepening my appreciation of the true beauty and significance of the liturgy and the way we worship."

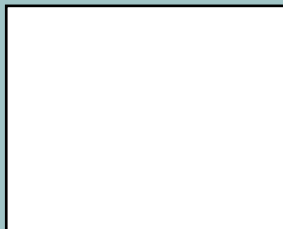
