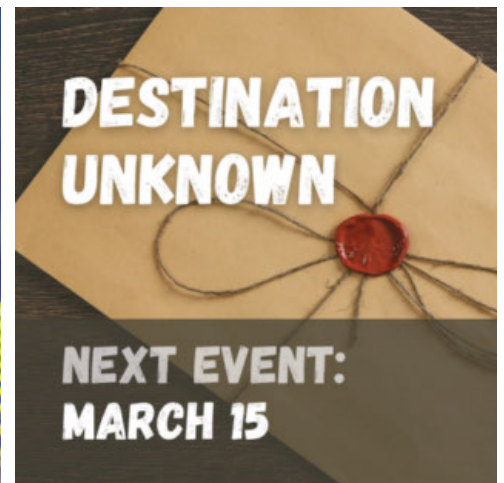
High School Youth Group Changes

New High School Event: "Destination Unknown"

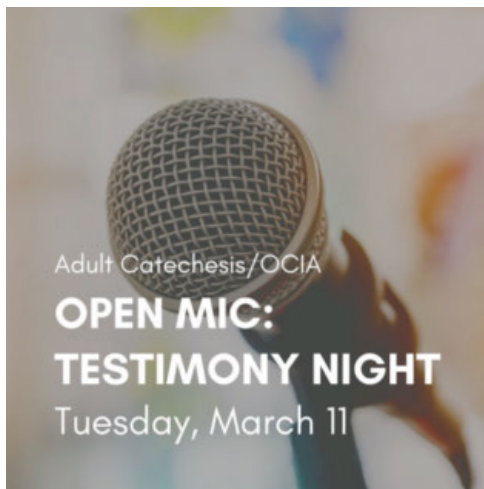

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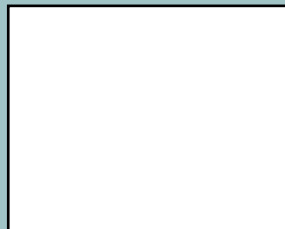
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
