

## Forward in Faith Second Collection

**We received \$5,044.50** from our last collection on March 16. Thank you for your continued support!



### What Do Our Goals Mean?

We're very close to reaching our \$10.8 million Celebration Goal, which will allow us to break ground on the Parish Hall, **but what does the other goal on the Campaign Thermometer mean?** 

### Our Celebration Goal of \$10.8 million is what we need to:

- Retire Phase I construction debt (COMPLETED FEB. 2024!)
- Reach Diocesan funding requirement\* of 65% of our project cost to celebrate breaking ground on the Parish Hall and parking expansion.

### Our Challenge Goal of \$15.2 million is what we need to:

 Raise remaining 35% of our construction costs to complete Parish Hall and expanded parking without taking on additional debt.
 This will be our next challenge as we move Forward in Faith!

We're looking forward to the day we can celebrate reaching our first milestone and break ground on the Parish Hall—but we'll keep working as we build! St. Philip's will continue fundraising after the \$10.8 million Celebration Goal is reached to ensure our parish takes on as little debt as possible.

### \*What is the Diocesan Funding Requirement?

The Diocese of Fort Worth requires 65% of the total building project cost (\$12.6 million) to be raised before beginning construction. The parish must also have 40% of the project available in cash on hand to begin. The remaining amount needed for our project can be financed, but St. Philip's will continue fundraising to reduce debt.







Gabriel Project case managers provide resource referrals and emergency financial assistance when appropriate, and in some instances moms are referred to long term case management to ensure that these families are set up for long-term thriving.



Those who are sick or homebound can often feel isolated, lonely, and disconnected from the parish. Friendly Visitors help by establishing and maintaining regular social interaction and by sharing their gifts of conversing and listening. The role of the Friendly Visitor Program is to be present to the care recipients as they attempt to find God in their life situation, by listening to them. Christian presence is the gift that the Friendly Visitor brings.

Although each case is unique, volunteers make visits on the average of once a week for one hour. Friendly Visitors always make these visits in pairs, and observe confidentiality, respect of the person, and acceptance of care receivers for who and where they are.


