## The Easter Octave

Easter is a celebration lasting over the course of 8 days. This isn't a random number, but refers back to Scripture: The story of Creation in Genesis describes each phase of Creation as the First Day, Second Day, etc., concluding with the Seventh Day, on which Creation was complete, and God rested. But on the first day of the week, that is, the eighth day, Christ rose from the dead; the eighth day or "octave" is the day of New Creation, and special feasts of the Church (like Easter) are celebrated for a period of eight days, or an "octave".

- Attend daily Mass: the Church celebrates each day of the Easter Octave like a "little Easter"
- Read the Daily Readings if you can't make it to Mass; they unfold the story of the Resurrection and Jesus' appearances to the Holy Women and His Disciples.
- **Feast**, even on Friday! (the Friday obligation for penance is lifted on the Friday after Easter!)

# Embrace Divine Mercy: One Simple Sunday Delivers Infinite Grace

This Divine Mercy Sunday, rediscover the beauty of performing a few simple acts of faith that bring profound spiritual rewards. Experience the healing power of God's mercy through the liberating effect of plenary indulgences and the promise of His most special grace in your life.

In her Diary, St. Faustina records a special promise given to her by Jesus: "My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy" (699).

The most special grace promised by our Lord for Mercy Sunday is nothing less than the equivalent of a complete renewal of baptismal grace in the soul: "complete forgiveness (remission) of sins and punishment."

**To receive the Extraordinary Graces of this feast,** the only condition is to receive Holy Communion worthily on Divine Mercy Sunday (or the Vigil celebration) by making a good confession beforehand and staying in the state of grace and trusting in His Divine Mercy.

In addition, a Plenary indulgence has been granted for the devout observance of the Second Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday): "A plenary indulgence, granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff) to the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in You!)..."





Formation: A reading from Sacred Scripture


