

We're excited to announce that our parishioner, Alex Jansen, will be receiving candidacy this June!


What is Candidacy? The Rite of

## Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

June is the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In 1856, Bl. Pope Pius IX designated the Friday following the feast of Corpus Christi as the feast of the Sacred Heart for the Universal Church. Ever since then, the month of June has been devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and His immense love for us.

Our Lord said to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque: "Behold this Heart which has so loved men that It spared nothing, even going so far as to exhaust and consume Itself, to prove to them Its love. And in return, I receive from the greater part of men nothing but ingratitude, by the contempt, irreverence, sacrileges and coldness with which they treat Me in this Sacrament of Love." Christ's love for us requires a response: We turn our lives over to Him without reserve. We must give to God His due Justice.

## **Justice Due to God**

Every time we turn on the news, we see people protesting in the streets, demanding rights, seeking justice for themselves or others. However, very little is said about the rights of God.

Our world acts as if God has no rights. Our Lord is offended, ridiculed and mocked in just about every platform there is, yet we owe Him our very lives. To make amends to God for all our neglects, we can practice daily the virtue of Justice.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church, Section 1807, defines Justice as "the moral virtue that consists in the constant and firm will to give their due to God and neighbor." Justice toward God is called the "virtue of religion." As devout Catholics, we must practice this virtue daily and encourage others to do the same. Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us!
