Kim Carr Retires from St. Philip Staff

17 years ago, Kim Carr was a St. Philip's parishioner who had recently retired from a career teaching in public and private schools. She had no idea that God had a "greater work" in mind for her: leading hundreds of children closer to Our Lord and preparing them to receive Him in Holy Communion for the first time. To this role, Kim brought her professional experience, a true gift for reaching children, and her own profound love of God, a love she communicated to others. All of these qualities helped Kim to faithfully form and serve each new generation of young parishioners, even through challenges such as the COVID-19 pandemic and our parish move to Flower Mound.

Reflecting on her time at St. Philip's, Kim had this to share:
"I saw this job advertised in the bulletin, and applied for it thinking, if I get it that's great, if not, that's fine too. But this turned into way more than I thought; it was really a calling that God had prepared me for. This has been so much more than a job, and meant more to me than I could ever express in words. I will miss working with all the children and families terribly, but I know that God has other things in store for me. I will always be praying for all the families at St. Philip."

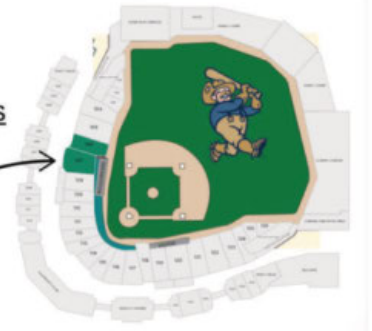

What is Candidacy? The Rite of Candidacy Mass is a significant milestone in the formation journey of a seminarian. It marks the Church formally recognizing a seminarian's intention and readiness to pursue Holy Orders. This rite typically takes place before a seminarian enters the theology stage of formation. The Rite of Candidacy is the Church's official acknowledgment that a seminarian has reached a level of maturity and discernment to be publicly accepted as a candidate for the priesthood.

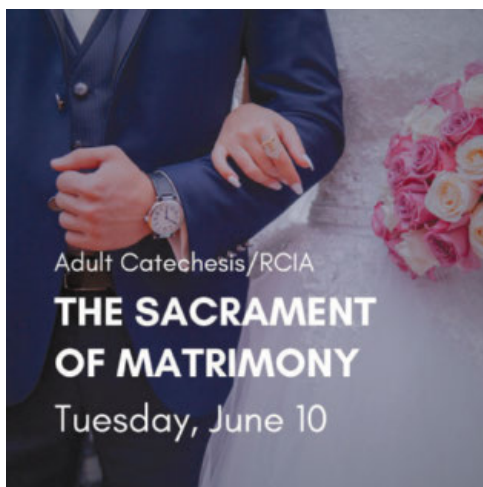

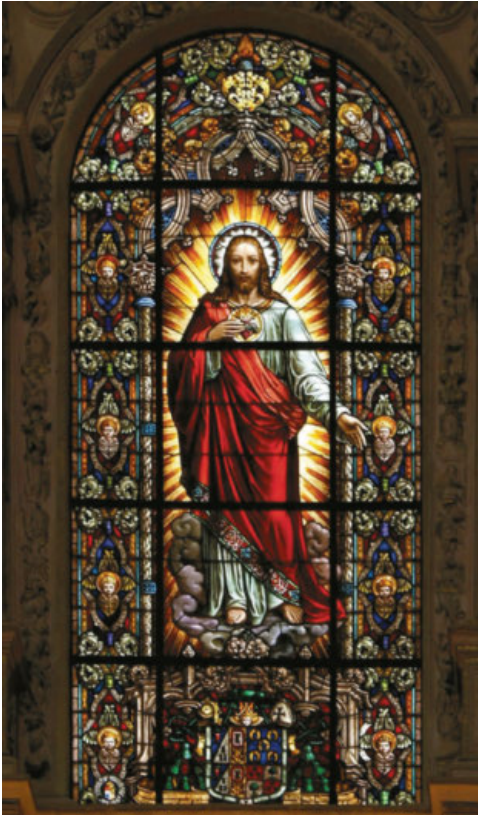

Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

June is the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In 1856, Bl. Pope Pius IX designated the Friday following the feast of Corpus Christi as the feast of the Sacred Heart for the Universal Church. Ever since then, the month of June has been devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and His immense love for us.

Our Lord said to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque: "Behold this Heart which has so loved men that It spared nothing, even going so far as to exhaust and consume Itself, to prove to them Its love. And in return, I receive from the greater part of men nothing but ingratitude, by the contempt, irreverence, sacrileges and coldness with which they treat Me in this Sacrament of Love." Christ's love for us requires a response: We turn our lives over to Him without reserve. We must give to God His due Justice.

Justice Due to God

Every time we turn on the news, we see people protesting in the streets, demanding rights, seeking justice for themselves or others. However, very little is said about the rights of God.

Our world acts as if God has no rights. Our Lord is offended, ridiculed and mocked in just about every platform there is, yet we owe Him our very lives. To make amends to God for all our neglects, we can practice daily the virtue of Justice.

The *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, Section 1807, defines Justice as **"the moral virtue that consists in the constant and firm will to give their due to God and neighbor."** Justice toward God is called the "virtue of religion." As devout Catholics, we must practice this virtue daily and encourage others to do the same. Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us!

Prayer to Christ The King

O Jesus Christ, I acknowledge Thee as Universal King.

All that has been made has been created for Thee.

Exercise all Thy rights over me.

I renew my Baptismal vows, renouncing Satan, his pomp and his works; and I promise to live as a good Christian.

In particular do I pledge myself to labor, to the best of my ability, for the triumph of the rights of God and Thy Church.

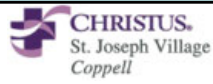

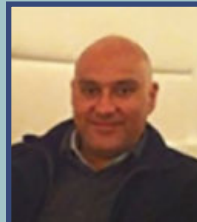

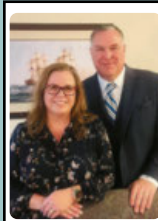
