


# Parent/Student Confirmation Orientation Meeting Monday, June 23, at 6:45 PM in St. Joseph Hall

Those in attendance will have the first choice of preparation session dates. After Orientation, the enrollment form will open to all at stphilipcc.org/confirmation

Teens must be at least 15 years old (or will turn 15 before the date of Confirmation) or in the 10th grade to be eligible for HS Confirmation. Preparation consists of attending 8 classes, learning certain pious practices, and completing an end-of-session assessment.



Nine years ago, prompted by a generous donation of crafting supplies, a group of parish women brainstormed about how best to use them. Inspired by the Holy Spirit, they chose to create handmade greeting cards for the volunteers who bring Holy Communion to the sick and homebound. Through this ministry, they were able to provide notes of encouragement to homebound parishioners.

Eventually, this small yet enthusiastic team, led by Maureen Borger, expanded their offerings to include bookmarks, tags for Thanksgiving and Christmas baskets, as well as a variety of cards which are donated to *Cards for Kindness* – a clearinghouse dedicated to providing cards to hospitals and groups in need throughout the United States.

The tireless Cardmakers continue to make cards for Easter, Christmas, Get Well, Anniversary, and Thinking of You; the parish staff and other ministries also use these cards to encourage those they serve. The ladies have taken on extra projects such as anniversary cards for Fr. Gerard Mary's 50<sup>th</sup> Priestly Ordination Anniversary, and for a local Senior Center whose residents sent cards to military groups for Veteran's Day.

These dedicated women work individually from home throughout the month and gather on the first Monday of each month in St. Joseph Hall to review progress on the project goals. Practicing sustainability, commercial cards are often recycled to make new designs, creating a unique homemade card.

**Producing an average of 400 cards a year**, the Cardmakers use their ministry to be His hands and feet, spreading the Good News to make Jesus better known and loved.
