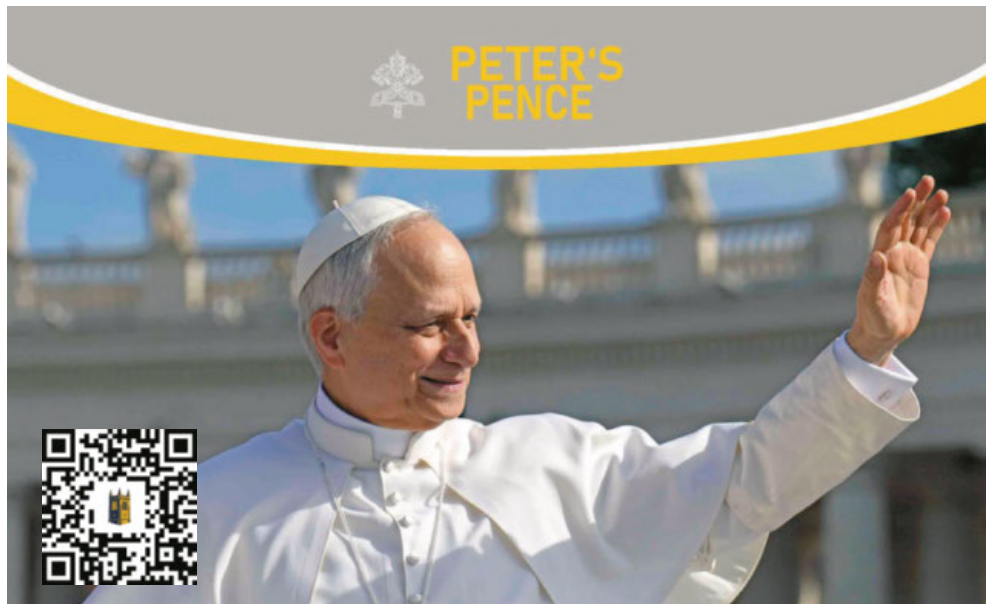

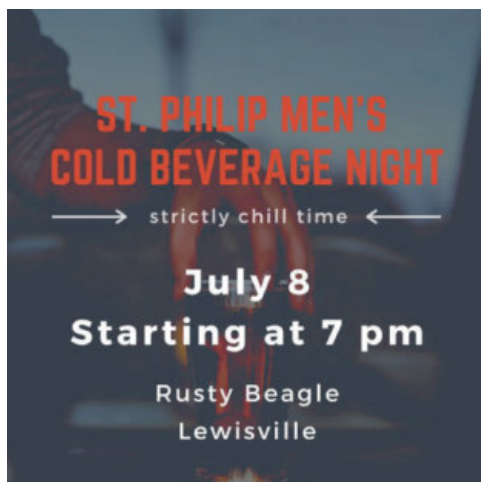

## High School Confirmation

In the Diocese of Fort Worth, the Sacrament of Confirmation is typically conferred on teens of at least 15 years of age. Teens can prepare while 14 years old, as long as they will be 15 at the time of Confirmation. Preparation consists of attending 8 classes, learning certain pious practices, and completing an assessment.

**At this meeting,** parents will receive important information regarding the sacramental preparation program, and also have first priority in signing up for one of the three available sessions (Fall Winter, and Summer sessions available). The meeting is geared toward parents, but children are welcome to attend.

A student preparing for First Penance/First Communion must be baptized in the Catholic Church and be seven or older, usually in 2nd grade. We also prepare children and teens in Grades 3-12.

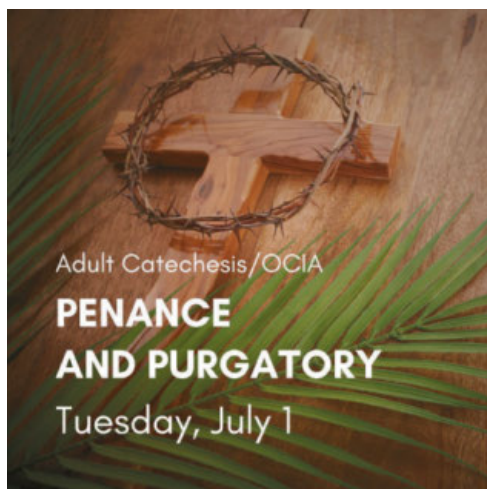

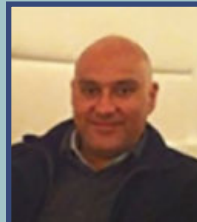

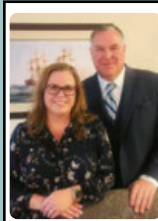
