Kindergarten—1st Grade

Meets Wednesdays from 5:15-6:15 in St. Joseph Hall

For families that would like to learn how you can foster your child's faith, we will meet together in Parent/Child classes. Families are the Domestic Church, where all learning has taken place since birth. You chose the Catholic Faith for your child at Baptism, and have modeled your faith by praying and attending Mass with them. Now, before the sacrament year in 2nd grade, let us work with you and your child to continue their formation in the Catholic Faith.

First Penance/First Communion

UPDATED: we now have two options for the Parent Orientation Meeting—please attend one.

At this meeting, parents will receive important information regarding the sacramental preparation program, and also have first priority in signing up for a session. The meeting is geared toward parents, but children are welcome to attend.

A student preparing for First Penance/First Communion must be baptized in the Catholic Church and be seven or older, usually in 2nd grade. We also prepare children and teens in Grades 3-12. Preparation for First Penance/First Communion is completed by children and parent(s) with a combination of a Parent Meeting, Home Study, and In-person Parent/Child classes.

3-5th Grade

Four class options available: Choose from Tuesdays 4:30-5:45 PM or 6:15-7:30 PM; Wednesdays from 5:15-6:30 PM or 7:15-8:30 PM. Over these three years, children study Salvation History, Prayer and Sacraments, and the Teachings of Christ. Classes reach all learning styles with games, videos, and activities so that students continue to grow in their faith and have community with other children.

Steps Between Milestones

The Sacraments are milestones in our lives and typically take place when we are an infant (Baptism), child (Confession/Communion), teen (Confirmation), and young adult (Marriage).

The steps between these milestones and beyond are critical to being fully formed in the Catholic Faith: **Formation is both sacramental preparation and catechism classes.**

St. Philip provides formation in the Catholic Faith at all points along this road. As you look forward to the next year, there may not be a sacramental "milestone" for your child in 2026, but the formation they receive in their Faith in this year is a crucial next step.

- **A Meal** (we do a variety; something different each week)
- **Social/Fellowship time**, either after the meal or in the form of a game at the end of the night
- **Discussion/Lesson** about a topic interesting to the high schoolers

One meeting of each month is a Just-for-Fun Sunday, where we skip the lesson and jump straight from the meal into fun and games. Just-for-Fun Sundays provide an extra easy entry point for newcomers and an easy way to invite new friends.

High School Discipleship Groups

High School Discipleship Groups are smaller, more personal formation settings in which groups of 4-8 young men or young women meet year-round for tailored catechesis and spiritual growth. Each group has two adult mentors. The aims of Discipleship Groups are:

- Personalized mentoring on how to live a Catholic life
- Accountability for concrete spiritual progress and holiness
- A Catholic friend-group centered on the pursuit of holiness together

In the Diocese of Fort Worth, the Sacrament of Confirmation is typically conferred on teens of at least 15 years of age. **Teens can prepare while 14 years old**, as long as they will be 15 at the time of Confirmation. Preparation consists of attending 8 classes, learning certain pious practices, and completing an assessment.

Haitian Pilgrims: Christmas in July!



Whatsoever you did to these, the least of my brothers and sisters, you did to me. - Matthew 25:40

Join us the weekend of July 26th & 27th for an opportunity to share a portion of our blessings with the men, women and children of our sister parish, St. Therese of Boileau, Haiti.

We are very excited to share that St. Therese School, which was sadly destroyed in a 2021 earthquake, has been rebuilt!

This \$450,000 project has taken three years of fund-raising and construction. Built to withstand 7.0 earthquakes, the new school has electricity for the first time, powered by solar panels. Improvements also include a complete kitchen and outdoor eating area, updated restroom facilities, and a new well. A playground with swings and climbing objects for the very young students is protected with a gated fence.

The Micro-credit program is assisting local farmers with the purchase of cows, pigs, lambs, goats, and bulls.

The Centre Materno et Infantile de Boileau clinic continues to provide excellent health care to pregnant women and their children. General health care is provided to all the people of Boileau and the surrounding areas. The clinic has now expanded to provide ophthalmology eye exams and glasses. We are very proud of Dr. Kellide, and her staff, for their excellent focus on improving the health of the people of Boileau. We are equally excited that two of our nurses are college scholarship beneficiaries.

The Moise Nacier Scholarship Program has 15 current beneficiaries attending college programs in Agronomy, Nursing, Engineering, Business Administration. For the first time, a St. Therese School graduate has been accepted to The University of Notre Dame Medical School in Port-au-Prince! Since 2013, we have awarded 37 scholarships. We truly believe that education is the key to a better future for Haiti.

How you can help:

Please join us in the tent July 26/27 to take a gift tag from the Christmas trees. The gift tags provide specific needs, everything from cows and goats to children's lunch food (Did you know that lunch costs only 14 cents per day per child?). You'll also find teacher's pay, college scholarships and many other items – something for everyone.

We also ask that you take a coin box and every day drop in your loose change or dollars over the next 100 days. In Haiti, the average daily wage is \$1 to \$3 US Dollars per day. When you return them the weekend of October 25/26, these small daily sacrifices will amount to a generous donation. You'll find our coin boxes in the tent and St. Joseph Hall.

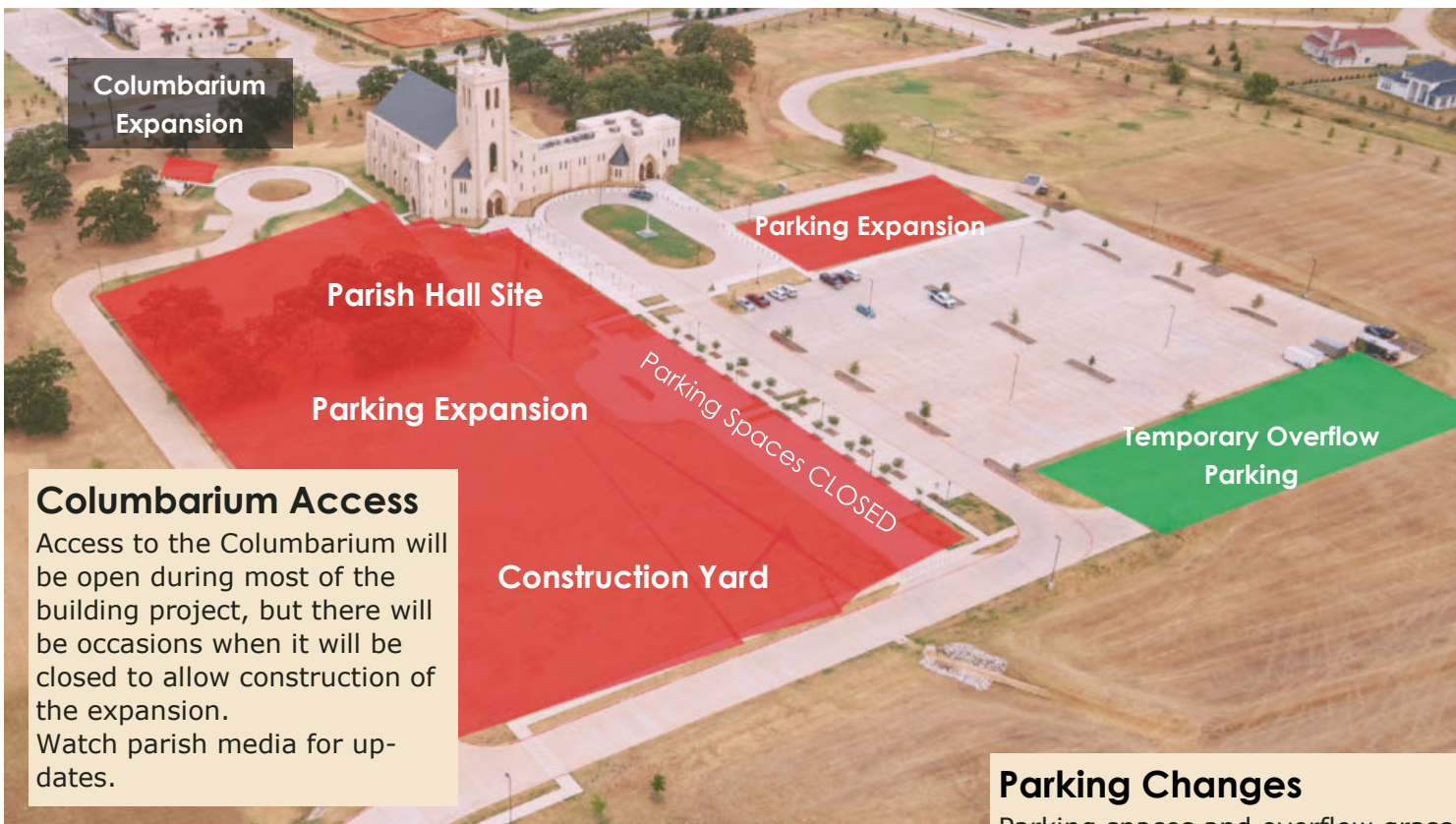

CONSTRUCTION OF THE PARISH HALL & PARKING
