

### Fr. Gerard Mary Anyanwu

Have you had the opportunity to meet Father Gerard Mary this summer?

Father Gerard Mary is a priest from Nigeria and is the founder of the Divine Face Organization (DFO). He comes to the United States each summer to do fundraising to support DFO; while here, he also helps out our parish by presiding at some of the Masses!



### **About the Divine Face Organization**

DFO provides all the financial support for Our Mother of Special Graces, the school founded by Fr. Gerard Mary in Nigeria. DFO is run entirely by volunteers, many of whom are St Philip's parishioners

Through the generosity of donors, Father has accomplished much since the first school buildings were constructed in 1994: he has added a secondary school with dorms, a chapel, and a bus to bring the children to the school. In 2013 the parishioners of St. Philip provided the funds for the Vocational Building, where students can learn sewing, plumbing, and welding. The school gives scholarships to the poor and provides the best education in the area. They also feed the poor in the area. The mission of DFO also supports some young men in seminary formation.

Working with our youth is 📋 a highly important, and also highly rewarding way to volunteer in our community. Teens in Middle School and High School receive critical formation in their Faith, lives, and friendships during this time; with your help, St. Philip's is working to provide the best programs to give our youth what they need to be strong and faithful Catholics. 




