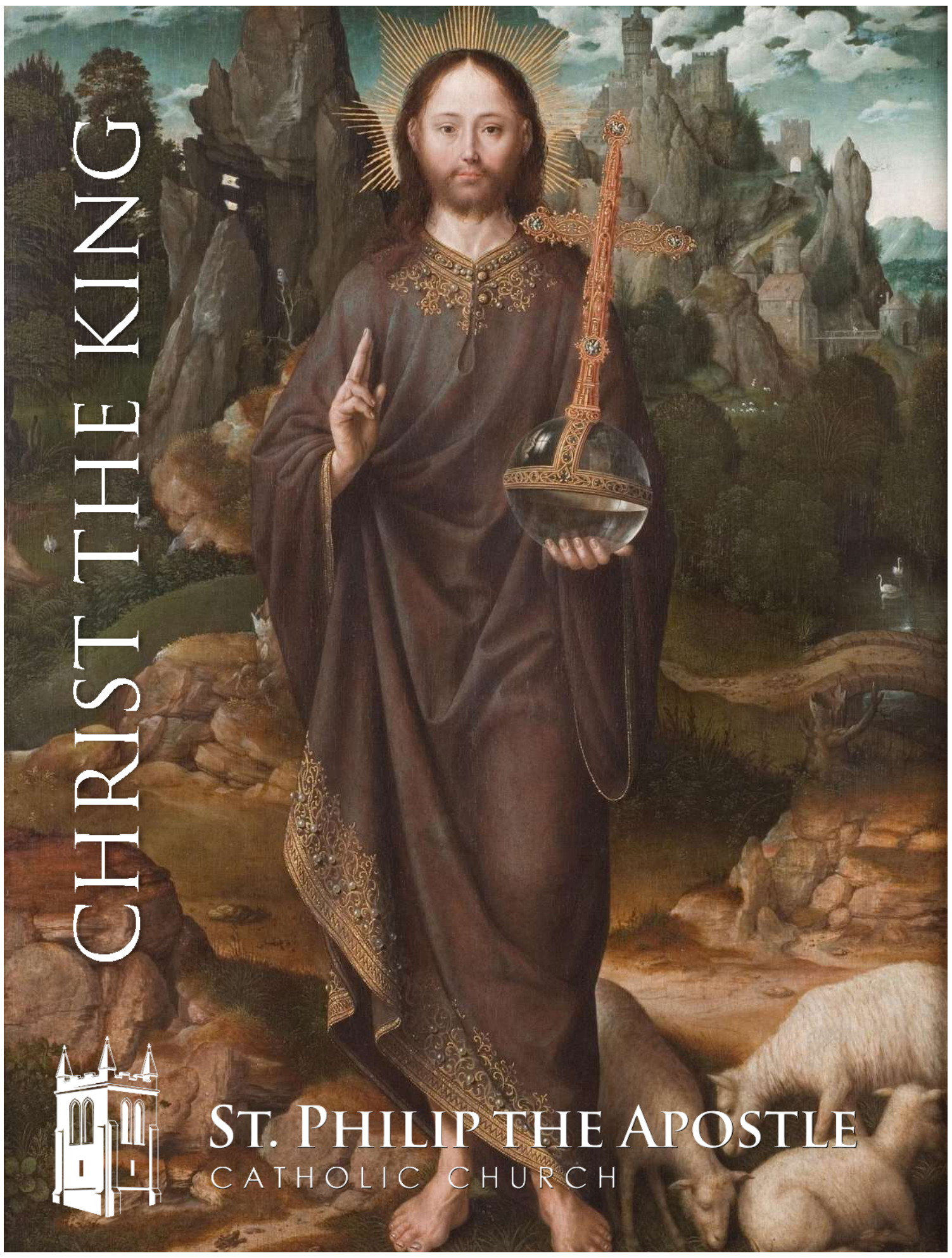

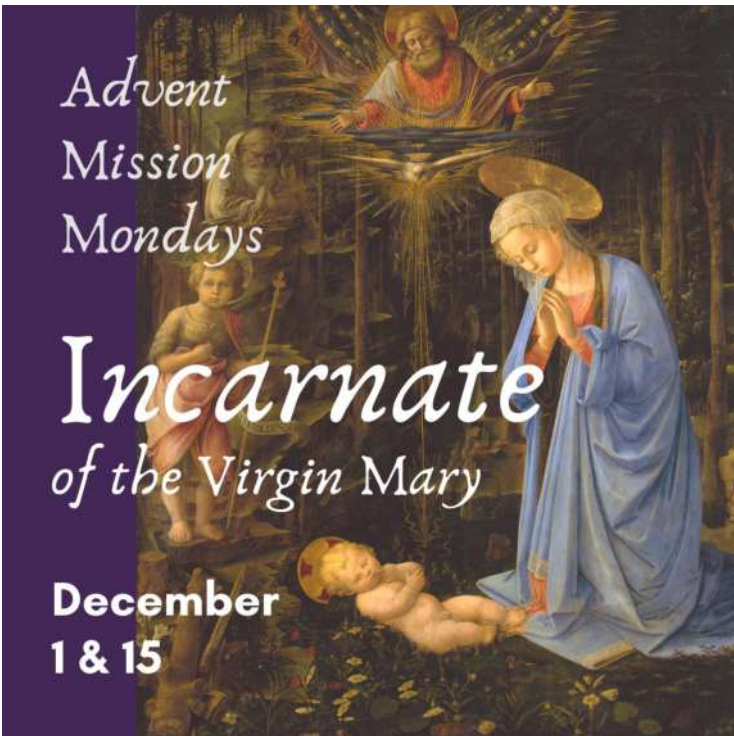


Men's Prayer Night

Advent Rorate Masses

**Saturdays in Advent: December 6, 13, and 20
Mass begins at 6 AM**

On the Saturdays of Advent this year we will celebrate special early morning Masses in honor of the Blessed Virgin and her role in bringing to birth our Savior. These candlelight Masses, called Rorate Masses, take their title from an Advent hymn in Latin that beautifully expresses their theme, as we pray "drop down dew, ye heavens, from above, and let the clouds rain down the just one: let the earth be opened and bring forth a Savior." (Our Masses will be in English.)

A Rorate Mass is traditionally celebrated just before dawn in Advent as a devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Mass is only lit by candles, representing Mary's role in bringing the Light of the World to us. Mass begins in darkness before sunrise, to remind us of a world in darkness and sin that is anticipating the coming of Christ. As a votive Mass for the Blessed Mother, white vestments are worn instead of the violet normally used during Advent. The Mass readings and prayers highlight the prophecies of the coming of Christ and Mary's role in bringing the Light into the world.

May the quiet darkness of these early Saturday mornings lead us to a more reflective and prayerful time as we prepare for the coming of the Savior at Christmas.

ADVENT BEGINS NOVEMBER 30

The weeks before Christmas are the busiest of the year, but it's just at this time that the Church asks us to withdraw a little.

Why? To make room for Christ in our lives. The first obstacle faced by Our Lord on His entry into this world was the fact that there was no room for Him; the Maker of all things was born in a stable. Similarly, it's easy to be so caught up in this truly wonderful time of year that we arrive at Christmas and have no room for Christ. It's also important to remember that the season of Advent is about preparing for Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. Do we continually make room for Him so that, when He comes, we will be ready?

Here are some tips for using Advent to "make room":

1. Mark a few things "Do Not Open Until Christmas." Like Lent, Advent is a penitential season (a time to practice prayer, fasting, and almsgiving) and setting aside some pleasures as a sacrifice is an important way to "make room" for what this season is truly about. *And when Christmas arrives, we celebrate!*

2. Keep visual reminders of Advent.

Place an Advent wreath in a prominent place in your home and light it during family meals. Set up the manger scene in readiness for the Holy Family to arrive, or make a Jesse Tree with your family!

3. Make Resolutions. Advent actually begins the Church's "New Year." What are some ways you can grow? Frequent Mass or daily prayer, as an individual or a family? Try the simple prayer of the St. Andrew Novena, which is prayed from November 30 until Christmas.

4. Seek spiritual growth. Make a good Confession and come to Daily Mass and Adoration as often as you can; consider formation opportunities like Mission Monday, or pick up some seasonal spiritual reading.

Christmas Novena

Prayed 15 times daily from November 30 – December 24

*Hail and blessed be the hour and moment in which the Son of God was born of the most pure Virgin Mary, at midnight, in Bethlehem, in piercing cold. In that hour, vouchsafe, O my God! to hear my prayer and grant my desires (**mention any special intentions**), through the merits of Our Savior Jesus Christ, and of His Blessed Mother. Amen.*

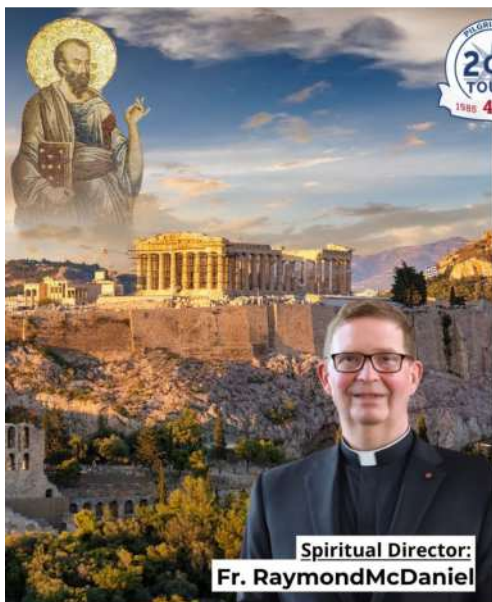
