Who was St. Blaise? Ancient martyrologies describe St. Blaise as a fourth-century bishop and martyr of Sebaste in Armenia. A famous story about St. Blaise relates that he saved a boy from choking to death on a fishbone; this, or the story that St. Blaise was a physician, may be the reason he is traditionally invoked by those suffering from throat illness.

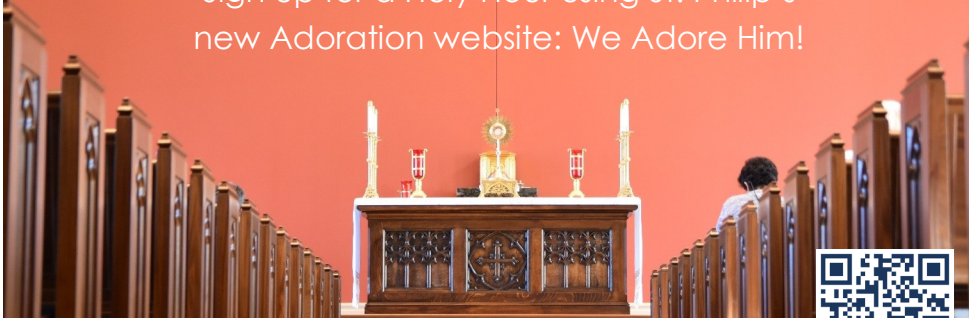

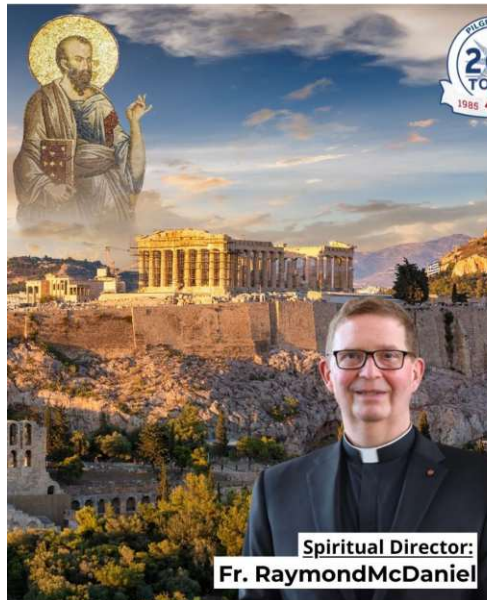
