

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear brothers and sisters, this week is the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary into heaven. This is the fourth glorious mystery of the rosary. The music of the chant from this Mass is my all time FAVORITE (YouTube: Mass of the Assumption)!! This special and sacred moment of Mary's life is our glimpse into what waits for those who love the Lord! Remember, she is the Immaculate Conception which means she was conceived without original sin. The fruit of sin is death and the someone that has no sin does not die. So when Mary's earthly life was over God simply took her, body and soul, to himself. "Heaven" is God himself, his presence and the wedding of us and him.

What do we think about when we think about heaven and "being holy"? Nothing that is not holy will enter heaven. "Holiness is not the luxury of the few. It is a simple duty for you and for me." (-St Teresa of Calcutta) It seems that many times we might think holiness is for "the few", not me and my life. Many biographies of saints might show them to barely be living in a body... Like they didn't go to the bathroom or ever have a beer. Of course we are all different because God made us that way so that we would shine a specific aspect of his love in the world. At this time of the year it is as if her mother Mary is telling us: "Do not be afraid to be holy. Do not be afraid to ask what this means for you in your life, in your home, in your job, and in the nitty-gritty of your daily life." If we think we will not have fun, that we will lose out on really living life and have to be weighed down by rules and that "big bad Catholic Church..." we got it all wrong!!! Think of this most holiest human ever to live, the most important person in our family next to God is Mary! And she really lived life by receiving the divine bridegroom himself into her womb and following him all the way to the depths of the cross where she became the mother of every person to ever walk this planet.

If we are honest with oneself and let our soul rest in silence with God...we will see that "our hearts are restless until they rest in Him" (-St Augustine). WE ARE MADE FOR HEAVEN. There is nothing here in earth, no experience or anything we can come up with that will satisfy the longing and hunger of our hearts. Only God is enough.

He patiently waits for us in the Mass, in the adoration chapel, in the confessional, in the people we encounter each day and in our hearts. He waits for us to seek him so that like Mary we can see that he is seeking us first! His will is to be our divine bridegroom and marry us so that we too will "go to heaven" one day with Mary and the saints after this very brief life. Do not be afraid to take Mary as your mother and live for heaven. Let's all take one step at a time and beg for the Holy Spirit to help us get rid of our "stinkin thinkin" that tells us "holiness" is not for me. If you are baptized, you are called to be holy.
