



A reminder of our guidelines for the new Volunteer Plaque for the Parish?
It will be called:

THANK-YOU

For 25 Years of Dedicated Service to St. Veronica's Parish

The guidelines are:

- a. The person has to have been a continuous volunteer for a minimum of 25 years in any volunteer capacity
- b. The person could be alive or deceased
- c. The names are to be put forward by family or parishioners with a short history of the tears of service. A picture would be asked so that we can put this information in a binder at the foot of the plaque. Names only will not be accepted you must write a description of the service.
- d. P.A.C. must approve all submissions
- e. Once a month on the coffee Sunday all the living volunteers will be awarded with an appreciation certificate and all invited downstairs for fellowship and congratulations. All deceased will also have a certificate given to family if appropriate. Both will be announced in the bulletin.
- f. The plaque will be placed in the main entrance of the Church

Excerpt from "Divine Renovation" by Father James Mallon

Over the last 50 years, our society has witnessed what can arguably be called the most accelerated social change in human history. As we have moved through several paradigm shifts in the last generation; the pastoral practice of the Catholic Church in the West remains for the most part, unchanged from what existed prior to this state of flux. Culture supported faith and church attendance. Demographics supported our pastoral development through the birth of children and the movement of immigrants. We just had to build it and people would come. I do not believe we were particularly good at making disciples 50 years ago, but it was not obviously to our detriment. As long as we would go and open churches, there were always new communities of migrants and new babies. As long as we baptized and taught in our schools, we pumped out good "practicing Catholics." In a sense, we got away with not making disciples, because the culture propped it all up. Fast forward through the 60s, the sexual revolution, mass media, new media, post-modernism, materialism, relativism, individualism, hedonism and every other "ism" we can think of and all of a sudden the fault lines are revealed for all to see.
