After much prayer, consideration and collaboration from Bishop McManus, diocesan leaders, and pastors, the Diocese of Worcester is embarking on a historic capital campaign that will help shape the future of the universal Catholic Church and our local parish of St. Denis.

It is my privilege to invite you to attend a reception inaugurating our Legacy of Hope Capital Campaign on Wednesday, August 21st at 12:00 pm. There will also be a reception on the same day at 7:00 pm in the Parish Hall. At these receptions, you will have an opportunity to hear from members of our parish leadership team regarding how this campaign will greatly benefit us as a parish and also as a diocesan family. As a parish leader, it is my hope that you will attend one of these events to learn about this historic campaign, the ministries, and programs it will support and to have your questions answered. We will receive 40% (\$65,473) of all monies raised to our parish goal. Here at St Denis our campaign goal is \$163,683 over the 4-year period. These funds raised from our parishioners will be used to address major urgent items such as the Church roof, which is now long overdue, Parish Hall and Church insulation need to be significantly improved, asphalt patching parking lot, the parish Hall restroom needs a major improvement hoping to make it ADA Disability accessible, etc.


Let us ask blessings upon our efforts to help secure the future of St Denis Church and the Diocese of Worcester.
