

But you were not made for comfort, you were made for greatness." "Comfort" puts me first. "Picking up your cross and following Jesus" puts God and others first. Why settle for comfort when you can achieve greatness! Pick up your cross, ask Jesus for guidance on using your gifts and live the life God intended



Reflection from Fr Hartford

Jesus speaks to us this weekend about the conditions of discipleship. Saying ," whomever does not take up his cross and follow me is not worthy of me." He means that nothing should ever come between him and his disciple. To follow Christ is to do what he asks of us. It means risking present life gains for eternal ones. Our Christian lives are based on self-denial and that involves the cross.

Many times in our lives we may be willing to accept any cross into our lives, except the one that has been given to us. Jesus goes on to say, "whomever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it." To seek one's own life in escaping the cross leads to losing it. But to set aside one's own interests or life for the cause of Christ is a life that is found. Jesus showed us by his own example of accepting the cross literally and now we are linked by the same spirit of dedication to God's will.

It is when we attempt to escape the cross that it has the power to crush us. But by the acceptance of the crosses in our lives start to bear fruit in ways that we could never have imagined. In surrendering our lives to Christ we truly become strong, in and through our weakness. Through our weakness, the power of Christ's cross works through us and touches the lives of others. We gain our own lives and enrich the world with Christ's resurrected life.


