



### A Project for the Entrance of Fr. Lacey Hall



Dear Parish Family,

In his letter to the Ephesians, the Apostle Paul says — "Now to him who is able to do above and beyond all that we ask or think according to the power that works in us—to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen." (Ephesians 3:20-21)

In saying that, thank you so much for your incredible support and generosity toward our parish needs. It is because of your generosity that we are happy to introduce our Project for the Entrance of Fr. Lacey Hall.

I would like to give a brief description of this coming-up Project to be done during the summer of this year and why the Project is needed.

It is already known by some of our parishioners that the porch of Fr. Lacey Hall is collapsing and condemned by the building inspector after rigorous inspection. The building inspector requires that the porch must be repaired according to the State Building Code. The contractor will remove and replace the existing front entry to Parish Hall. It is important to mention that the porch will be demolished and rebuilt with the same design. New stairs, roofs, windows, and banisters will be done. Our Parish Building Committee will make sure that everything is in accordance with the State Building Code.

The estimated Project Costs, including construction, design, and permits, will be around \$15,000. Our option for payment of this project is the money we got from the Legacy of Hope Campaign. This is why it is important to give, share, and do charity whenever possible because you never know how many people in our parish you will touch with your sharing.

It is important to know that the Project was reviewed and approved by our Parish Building Committee, our Finance and Parish Council. However, according to the Diocesan Policies, any constructions, or renovations over \$10.000 must-have Bishop's approval.

I cannot wait to see what God is going to do this year through each one of us and our church in Ashburnham. It is an absolute honor to serve you and Saint Denis Parish as priest, and I believe the best is yet to come.

With a sincere heart, I thank you for allowing God to use you through your prayer, serving, and giving so that we can fulfill the mission God has given us. Many blessings to you and your family.
