Worldwide Marriage Encounter - Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

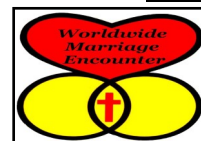

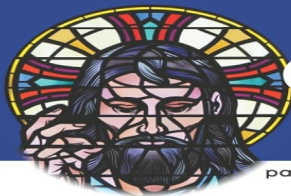
