

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the atrium, we introduce the children to the liturgical year firstly by looking at the colors of the liturgical seasons. Children are introduced to the colors of the year—Purple for Preparation, getting ready for a feast; The time of celebration is white, focusing on the feasts of Christmas and Easter; green is the color of Ordinary time, introduced as the growing time, a time to allow the "food of the feast" to nurture our growing relationship with God; the color red is for the Holy Spirit and the feast of Pentecost.

As children progress through the atrium we look at a circular liturgical calendar. This highlights the cyclical nature of the liturgical year. Essentially this work is a puzzle that the children pull apart and reconstruct, providing time for the children to reflect and notice different elements of our liturgical cycle. Gathering a deeper understanding of our Liturgical Year help the children more deeply participate in Mass and a liturgical life.
