The St. Francis Center services extremely low-income families, their children, and seniors. At the same time, the Center continues its original mission to help the homeless. The Center is located in the shadow of the downtown sports complexes near USC, specifically servicing the Garment District and South Park District of inner-city Los Angeles. In an area marked by sweatshops, gang violence, and drugs, St. Francis Center has become a refuge for the marginalized and a voice for the weak, primarily Latino and African-American families with an average monthly income of about \$550.
