The Center is located in the shadow of the downtown sports complexes near USC, specifically servicing the Garment District and South Park District of inner-city Los Angeles. In an area marked by sweatshops, gang violence, and drugs, St. Francis Center has become a refuge for the marginalized and a voice for the weak, primarily Latino and African-American families with an average monthly income of about \$550.
