Divine Mercy Ministry at St. Julie's Church - Monthly Gathering Announcement

Join us for our Divine Mercy group meetings, held on the first Sunday of each month at St. Julie's Church. Please note that if the first Sunday coincides with a special Parish Event, the meeting date may vary.

About the Divine Mercy Ministry:

The Divine Mercy Ministry at St. Julie's is deeply rooted in the apparitions experienced by Sister Faustina in Krakow, Poland, between 1931 and 1935. During these visions, Sister Faustina engaged in profound conversations with Jesus Christ, emphasizing the importance of complete trust in the Lord.



- The Divine Image: As revealed to Sister Faustina, depicting Jesus with rays of mercy emanating from His heart.
- Divine Mercy Sunday: Celebrated on the second Sunday of Easter, emphasizing God's boundless mercy.
- The Hour of Great Mercy: A specific time for prayer and reflection on Jesus' Passion.
- The Divine Mercy Novena: A nine-day prayer cycle leading up to Divine Mercy Sunday.
- The Chaplet of Divine Mercy: A specific prayer using rosary beads for intercession and mercy.

Significant Milestones:

- March 7, 1992: Sister Faustina's virtues were officially recognized as heroic.
- December 21, 1992: A miraculous healing, attributed to her intercession, was acknowledged.
- April 18, 1993: Pope John Paul II beatified Sister Faustina, conferring upon her the title of 'Blessed'.
- April 30, 2000: The Great Jubilee Year saw Sister Faustina canonized as a saint by Pope John Paul II, marking her as the first saint of the new millennium. This event also established the universal celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday within the Catholic Church.

This group would not be possible without the dedication and guidance of two special individuals in our community. We extend our heartfelt thanks to Virginia Witt for her leadership and to Deacon Barry for his insightful lessons and guidance in this beautiful ministry.
