



## LITURGICAL CORNER All About LENT!



To most people, prayer, fasting and almsgiving pretty much sums up what this 40-day penitential season is all about. But why does the Church even have Lent?

Throughout the year, we're not always conscious of our sins, or focusing on our relationship with God, or even growing as His disciples. So for six weeks, roughly forty days, the Church sets this time aside to give us an opportunity to be more conscious of our sins and place ourselves on a path of true conversion. So why is the Lenten season forty days and not 30 or 20 or some other number?

Forty days is the traditional number of disciplines, devotions, and preparations in the Bible. Moses stayed on the Mountain of God for forty days (Exodus 24:18, 34:28). Elizah traveled forty days before reaching the cave where he had his vision (1 Kings 19:8). The prophet Jonah announced to the people of Nineveh that they had forty days to repent (Jonah 3:4). Most importantly, prior to undertaking his ministry, Jesus spent forty days in the wilderness praying and fasting (Matthew 4:2).

Jesus gave us this example of a penitential retreat by spending prayerful time in the desert preparing for his ministry while reflecting on God's will and determining how he would make that happen.

Lent offers us the same opportunity: to withdraw from our routine and evaluate our spiritual progress or regression. We do this through reflection and repentance. In this way, we can deepen our relationship with God, draw closer to Him, and pray for the strength to resist temptation.

During this time, we seek the Lord in prayer and by reading Sacred Scripture, practice self-control through fasting, and serve others through giving alms. Easy to do? On the contrary. It is, however, a time which calls us to a true conversion of our heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully.


The Cross of Gratitude is currently on display in our Shrine Church until February 4, 2024. The Cross of Gratitude has been blessed by the last three Popes:


