THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT THE CATHOLIC CHURCH Stella Maris - Our Lady, Star of the Sea



This title was given to Mary since her role served as the "guiding star" on the way to Christ and dates back to Saint Jerome during the 4th century. On May 24, 1953, Pope Pius XII in his encyclical said, "... for as the ray does not diminish the brightness of the star, so neither did the Christ born of her tarnish the beauty of Mary's virginity."

The idea of Mary as a guiding star for seafarers has led to devotions to Our Lady, Star of the Sea, in many Catholic coastal and fishing communities. She also serves as the patron saint for ship chaplains, seafarers, fishermen and all who work or travel by sea, and has been referred to as the "Calmer of storms."

In every major country, a bishop serves as the Stella Maris Episcopal Promoter, overseeing the work of the national director, whose responsibility is to coordinate the individual chaplain's efforts and to assist them in developing their ministries.

The Mission of Stella Maris provides seafarers, who are often away from their home parishes, and some seafarers who have no parish setting, help them maintain lasting ties with their faith and families. In addition, the organization makes available spiritual renewal, a safe haven while in port, a safe work environment, a just contract, and communications with loved ones back home. As a result, a network of Stella Maris port offices and Catholic chaplains establish parishes that accommodate a seafarer's unique lifestyle and needs. Reverend Daniel J. McLearen is chaplain of the Stella Maris Port of New England located in New Haven, Connecticut.

Our Lady, Star of the Sea, is the patroness of the Netherlands, as well as the state of Hawaii. The Roman Catholic Church commemorates the Feast of Mary, Star of the Sea, on September 27th. Ceremonies such as the Blessing of the Fleet in New Bedford, the nation's #1 fishing port, continue to provide opportunities for the fishing community to come together to celebrate the fleet and remember those who have been lost at sea.
