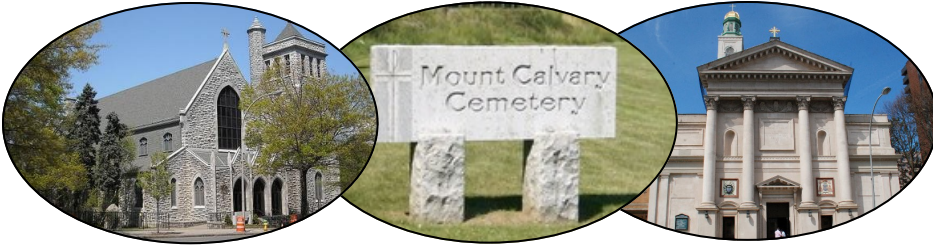

~ *Pastor's Column* ~

The last two precious gifts given to us by Jesus are the Holy Eucharist as our spiritual food on Holy Thursday and Jesus' mother Mary as our spiritual Mother on Good Friday. *Corpus Christi* is the celebration of the abiding presence of a loving God as *Emmanuel* – God with us – in order to give collective thanks to our Lord for his living with us in the Eucharist. The feast also gives us an occasion to learn more about the importance and value of the "Real Presence" so that we may appreciate and better and receive maximum benefit from the Sacrament.

We believe in the "Real Presence" of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist because Jesus promised it after miraculously feeding the 5000. Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist during his Last Supper. Jesus commanded his disciples to repeat it in his memory. "Nothing is impossible for God." We explain the Real Presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist by: the Aristotelian philosophical term "transubstantiation" which means that the *substance* of the consecrated bread and wine is changed to the *substance* of the risen Jesus' glorified Body and Blood by the action of the Holy Spirit, and its *accidents* (like color, shape, taste etc.), remain the same.

The first reading describes how Moses, by sprinkling the blood of a sacrificed animal on the altar and on the people, accepted the Covenant Yahweh proposed and made with His People. St. Paul affirms that Jesus sealed the New Covenant with his own Blood the second reading, thereby putting an end to animal sacrifices. The Gospel details how Jesus converted this ancient ritual into a Sacrament and sacrifice. Instead of the lamb's blood, Jesus offered his own Body and Blood, and instead of sprinkling us with blood, he put it into our hands as Food: "*Take, this is my Body*" (He did not say "This represents my Body"), and "*This is my Blood of the Covenant, which is poured out for many.*"

Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist both as a sacramental banquet and a sacrificial offering. As a sacrament, the Eucharist is a visible sign that gives us God's grace and God's life and, as a meal, it nourishes our souls. As a sacrifice the Eucharistic celebration is a re-presentation or re-enactment of Jesus' sacrifice on Calvary, completed in His Resurrection. We offer Jesus' sacrifice to God the Father for the remission of our sins, using signs and symbols. Let us appreciate the "Real Presence" of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist, by receiving Him with true repentance for our sins, due preparation and reverence. Let us be Christ-bearers and conveyers: By receiving Holy Communion, we become Christ-bearers as Mary was, with the duty of conveying Christ to others at home and in the workplace, through love, mercy, forgiveness and humble and sacrificial service.

EL CUERPO Y LA SANGRE DE CRISTO

“Yo soy el pan vivo bajado del cielo, dice el Señor, el que coma de este pan vivirá para siempre.”



Jesucristo murió, resucitó y subió a los cielos, y está sentado a la derecha de Dios Padre. Pero también permanece en la hostia consagrada, en todos los sagrarios del mundo. Y allí está **vivo**, en Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad; es decir: con todo su ser de Hombre y todo su ser de Dios, para ser alimento de nuestra vida espiritual. Es este gran misterio lo que conmemoramos en la fiesta de Corpus Christi.

Pero el milagro del Cuerpo de Cristo va mucho más lejos: estar en Misa es estar también en el Calvario y en el cielo. En efecto, la Santa Misa es el milagro más grande de tiempo y espacio que podemos vivir.

La Santa Misa no es una repetición del sacrificio de Cristo en el Calvario, sino que es exactamente el mismo sacrificio del Calvario: como si los asistentes a la Misa estuviéramos allá a los pies de la cruz en aquel primer Viernes Santo.

La consagración es el Calvario. Pero en la comunión recibimos a Jesús Resucitado, **vivo**, para El comunicarnos su Vida.
