## Domingo De Resurrección

***“Cristo ha resucitado,  
Aleluya”***



La Resurrección de Jesucristo es el misterio más importante de nuestra fe cristiana. En la Resurrección de Jesucristo está el centro de nuestra fe cristiana y de nuestra salvación. Por eso, la celebración de la fiesta de la Resurrección es la

más grande del Año Litúrgico, pues si Cristo no hubiera resucitado, vana sería nuestra fe... y también nuestra esperanza. Y esto es así, porque Jesucristo no sólo ha resucitado El, sino que nos ha prometido que nos resucitará también a nosotros. Así pues, la Resurrección de Cristo nos anuncia nuestra salvación; es decir, ser santificados por El para poder llegar al cielo. Y además nos anuncia nuestra propia resurrección, pues Cristo nos dice: “el que cree en Mí tendrá vida eterna: y yo lo resucitaré en el último día” (Jn. 6,40). La Resurrección del Señor recuerda un interrogante que siempre ha estado en la mente de los seres humanos: ¿Habrá vida después de esta vida? ¿Qué sucede después de la muerte? La Resurrección de Jesucristo nos da respuesta a todas estas preguntas. Y la respuesta es la siguiente: seremos resucitados, tal como Cristo resucitó y tal como El lo tiene prometido a todo el que cumpla la voluntad del Padre (Juan 5,29 y 6,40). Su Resurrección es primicia de nuestra propia resurrección y de nuestra futura inmortalidad. No sucede enseguida de la muerte, porque en la muerte quedan separados el alma del cuerpo. La muerte consiste precisamente en esa separación. Pero la resurrección sí sucederá en el “último día”; es decir, en segunda venida de Cristo: “Cuando se dé la señal por la voz del Arcángel, el propio Señor bajará del cielo, al son de la trompeta divina. Resucitaremos para la vida eterna en el cielo -los que hayamos obrado bien- y resucitaremos para la condenación -los que hayamos obrado mal.

**Comienza el Domingo de Pascua  
Termina con las Vísperas de Pentecostés**

La Pascua dura 50 días. El domingo de Pascua es para el año lo que el domingo es para la semana. Vivimos como si el reino de Dios ya hubiera venido, porque ya ha venido y es una realidad. Suspendemos el ayuno para darnos la celebración. Nos bendecimos nosotros mismos con el agua bautismal para recordar nuestra participación en la Pasión, Muerte y Resurrección de Cristo. Cantamos “Aleluya” porque nos deleitamos alabando al Señor. Los relatos que se proclaman de la Sagrada Escritura nos llevan al encuentro de María Magdalena y Tomás con el Señor resucitado, a comer con Jesús, a seguir al Buen Pastor, y a recibir al Espíritu Santo. Así como la Iglesia se recrea con los nuevos cristianos durante la Vigilia Pascual, en el tiempo pascual es común que se celebre los sacramentos de la Confirmación y la Primera Comunión, así como del Matrimonio y las Ordenes Sagradas.
