Did you know? The current building project we are working on is **Phase 2** of a **Five phase Master Plan**. The master plan was created when Fr. Dick Ward was the pastor here back in 2002.

Phase 1—this phase included new carpet in the church narthex and sanctuary, stucco repair and upgrades and construction to prepare the school to open. (Completed in 2007)

Phase 2— Current project to include an elevator. a new entrance for the church/school, large entrance gathering space, additional meeting spaces, and seismic upgrades to the school building. (**Anticipated completion spring 2019**)

Phase 3— A "Gymnasium/Parish Hall"! The proposed location is north of the school building.

Phase 4— New Two Story School Building (located west of the current school building in the lower parking area)

Phase 5—New Administration offices/Conference rooms (located south of the church building).
