Building Update 3/12/19— The backfill has been fully completed and the old concrete entry has been removed as the preparation for the pouring up the upper slab continues. The upper slab is scheduled to be poured Wednesday (3/13/19)! The window panels have been removed from the school building offices, and the next steps will be to remove the overhang on the school building in preparation for framing to begin upstairs and downstairs!
