

Building update 5/14/19: This week's updates include the finished roof on the school building! It has been sealed, while the downspouts and gutters will be installed later. This week, the HVAC (heating & cooling) system is being installed for the new gathering space, and a one hour fire rated wallboard is being installed on the exterior of the new area.

In new developments, after a financial review with the finance council, it has been determined that it will be feasible to recover the pews along with the new flooring in the sanctuary! We are very excited to make this change after receiving feedback from the community. It will bring the everything together and feel like a new space!
