Building Project Update

Building Update 7/10/19 - The external brickwork has been completed, and we are down to the final steps on the stucco as well. Secure/keyless hardware has been installed on the school building doors, and we are expecting the new carpet in the choir area and the baptismal font area to start on July 15th. We will potentially need a few bodies after Mass on Sunday to carefully lift the piano down from the choir area so the carpet installation can begin. The flooring team will continue to work on the ramp and continue laying tile throughout the remainder of the project.

Volunteer Appreciation


Thank you to all of our volunteers who participate in Adoration for your patience while the Chapel was unavailable. Adoration resumed July 8th.
