Dear parishioners,

I really enjoyed meeting so many of you this last weekend! I have felt very welcomed here! I still haven't gotten to spend much time with anyone outside of Sunday Masses, though. Another thing that made me happy was to see the possibilities of our new hall space as well.

Which leads me into a couple of requests:

First of all, if anyone has worked as an interior designer/has significant experience, could you let me know? As the work finishes and we begin to utilize the hall full-time, we want to ensure it remains a welcoming and inviting space into the future, which means putting some thought and energy into planning that.

But I've been made aware of a number of other needs around the parish as well.

One area where you can put yourself in service to the less-fortunate is through bringing Holy Communion to the sick and homebound. I can't do it by myself! Please let the office know you want to join us in forming our young people in following Jesus this year.
