Perception is Everything!

One does not live on bread alone, but by every word that comes forth from the mouth of God. Mt 4:4

Like a poison, misperception can damage or even destroy a relationship with God. This was the case with the Jews in today's gospel. Seeing the signs Jesus did on the diseased, a multitude of people followed Jesus. He taught them, not like their scribes and Pharisees, but as one having authority. As if healing diseases was not enough, Jesus topped it off by feeding over five thousand people with five barley loaves and two fish. Not since Moses have such amazing wonders happened in Israel. Yet, the people knew that even Moses paled in comparison to Jesus. His works and teachings far superseded those of Moses and the prophets.

But Jesus' time was a period of great hardship in Israel. Having been conquered by the Romans, the Jews were going through an economic and political hardship. Consequently, there was a huge yearning and desperation for a savior like Moses and the Maccabees. The Jews were understandably concerned with the alleviation of their immediate sufferings. So they flocked to Jesus for that alleviation and a possible political liberation. It was a dangerous misconception and Jesus, knowing that perception is everything, was not going to ignore it. He then challenged their wrong perception of him and the signs:

Amen, amen, I say to you, you are looking for me not because you saw signs but because you ate the loaves and were filled. Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. Jn 6:26-27

Jesus wanted them to look beyond the miracles and see the Lord of the miracles. He wanted them to see him for who he is, the Savior of the world, the bread of life, which came down from heaven. Some eventually saw him and followed him. Others could not and stopped following him (John 6:66).

But, are we really different from those Jews? How many times have we allowed our immediate problems cloud our perception of God? How many times have we let our relationship with God be conditioned by what we want from God and not by what he wills for us? How many times have we failed to see the bigger picture, that the Kingdom of God and our salvation far outweigh all our problems? "Seek first his kingdom and his righteousness", says Jesus, "and all these things will be given to you as well" (Mt 6:33). It is not the other way round.

Como un veneno, la percepción errónea puede dañar o incluso destruir una relación con Dios. Este fue el caso de los judíos en el evangelio de hoy. Al ver las señales milagrosas que Jesús realizó con los enfermos, una multitud comenzó a seguirlo. Él les enseñaba, no como los escribas y fariseos lo hacían, sino como alguien que tenía autoridad. Y como si curar enfermedades no hubiera sido suficiente, Jesús también alimentó a más de cinco mil personas con cinco panes y dos pescados. Desde Moisés no sucedían tales maravillas en Israel. Sin embargo, la gente sabía que incluso Moisés palidecía en comparación con Jesús. Sus obras y enseñanzas superaban aquellas de Moisés y los profetas.

Pero el tiempo de Jesús fue un periodo difícil en Israel. Habiendo sido conquistados por los romanos, los judíos estaban atravesando una situación económica y política muy difícil. En consecuencia, había un gran anhelo y una gran desesperación por encontrar un salvador como Moisés y los Macabeos. Comprensiblemente, los judíos estaban preocupados por encontrar un alivio para su sufrimiento inmediato. Así que acudieron a Jesús para encontrar ese alivio y una posible liberación política. Esta era una percepción errónea y Jesús, sabiendo que la percepción lo es todo, la desafió, diciéndoles:

Yo les aseguro que ustedes no me andan buscando por haber visto señales milagrosas, sino por haber comido de aquellos panes hasta saciarse. No trabajen por ese alimento que se acaba, sino por el alimento que dura para la vida eterna y que les dará el Hijo del hombre. Jn 6:26-27

Jesús quería que miraran más allá de los milagros y vieran al Señor de los milagros. Quería que lo vieran por lo que él es, el Salvador del mundo, el pan de vida que ha bajado del cielo. Algunos eventualmente lograron verlo y lo siguieron. Otros no pudieron y dejaron de seguirlo (Juan 6:66).

Pero, ¿seremos realmente diferentes a los judíos? ¿Cuántas veces hemos permitido que nuestros problemas inmediatos nublen nuestra percepción de Dios? ¿Cuántas veces hemos permitido que nuestra relación con Dios esté condicionada por lo que queremos de Dios y no por lo que él quiere para nosotros? ¿Cuántas veces nos negamos a ver el gran esquema de las cosas, que el Reino de Dios y nuestra salvación son mas importantes que nuestros problemas? "Busquen primero el reino de Dios y su justicia ", dice Jesús, " Y todo lo demás vendrá por añadidura" (Mt 6:33). Y no al revés.

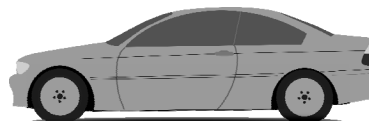

IN THE COMMUNITY...**Did You Know?****Gender divides in childhood can perpetuate abusive behaviors**

Parents of young children have likely heard the phrase “boys will be boys” many times — usually to excuse so-called “typical boy” behaviors. But this rationalization can extend dangerously through adulthood, to excuse sexual assault and harassment. The messages received by young children have lasting effects. Boys hear that they need to hide their emotions, so if they are abused, they’re less likely to come forward. Girls hear that boys can be rough or rude, and learn to tolerate rather than push back. ¿Sabía usted?**PROMESA DE PROTEGER**

Los padres de niños pequeños suelen repetir la frase de que “los varones son varones” para justificar ciertas conductas masculinas. Pero este entendimiento podría ser un modelo peligroso para la etapa adulta, ya que esos argumentos podrían justificar el abuso sexual y la violación. Recuerden que los mensajes que les transmitimos a los hijos tienen un efecto duradero. Además, cuando los niños aprenden que los “varones” no deben mostrar sus emociones, esto podría ser peligroso en caso de un abuso sexual, ya que ellos no querrían contar lo sucedido. Y cuando las niñas escuchan que los varones tienen que ser duros y poco corteses, ellas también aprenden que ellos deben ser tolerados en vez de rechazados. Eliminando la diferenciación de género en la crianza de los hijos/hijas podría ayudar a combatir el abuso sexual y las violaciones. 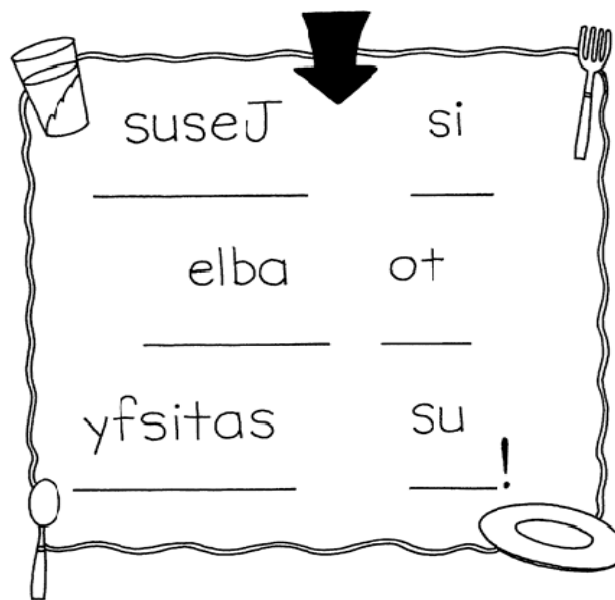
