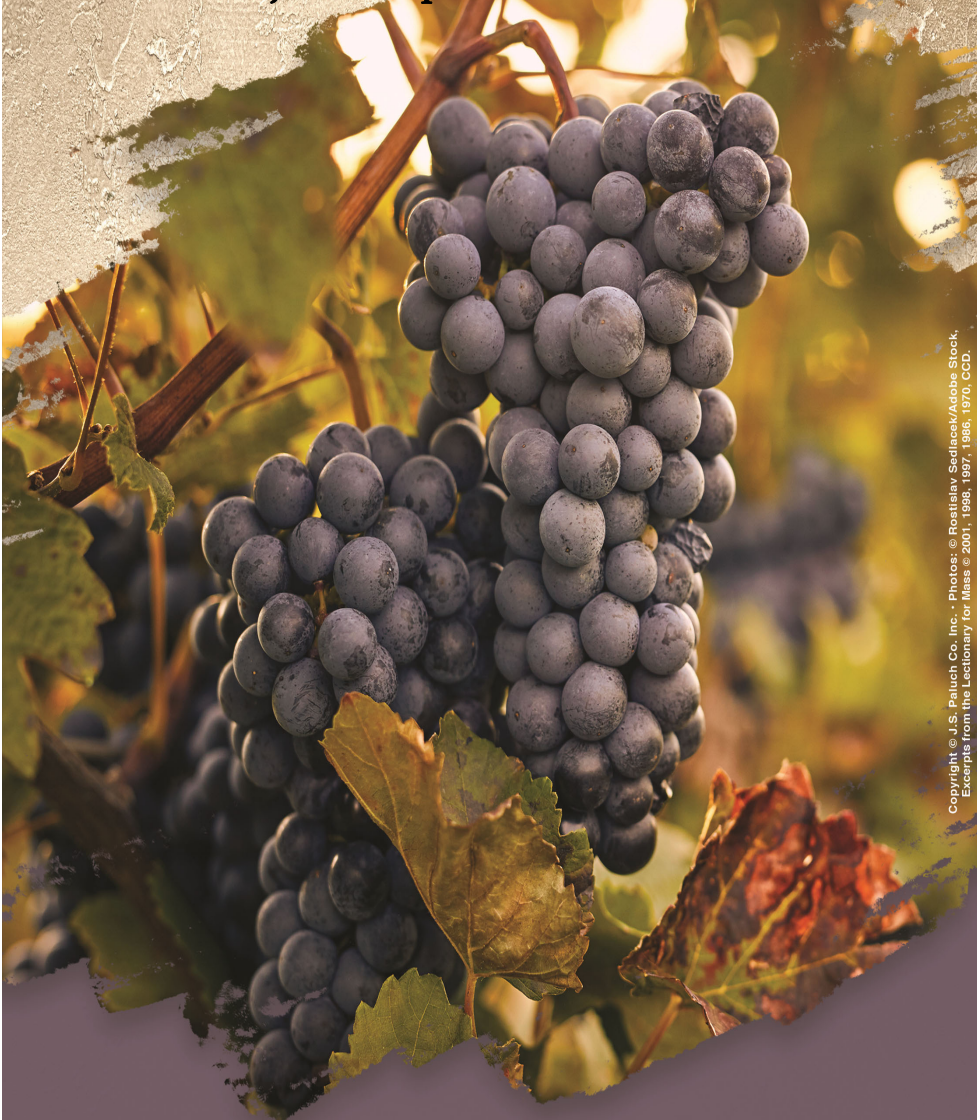

Theology of the Body

Part 4: *The Threefold Lust and the Insatiability of Man's Heart*

Without any doubt, the human body holds the secrets of the mysteries of heaven and divinity. Whatever is true, good, beautiful and perfect is divinely coded into the human body. It holds the power to transmit and perpetuate life on earth. It is the *substratum* of the communion between man and woman. But, as we have seen from previous reflections, something went awfully wrong, derailing the plan of God *"from the beginning"* (Gen 2:24-25; Mt 19:8). In spite of the problems mentioned before, there is still a lingering problem of lust or concupiscence. Why are we plagued by problems surrounding sexuality: lustful thoughts, addictions to sex, pornography and rape, sexual molestation, exploitation and perversion, and lack of self-control? Why the objectification of the human body? How was God's blessing turned into a curse?

The Threefold Lust or Concupiscence

According the Scriptures and the Fathers of the Church, the original sin of Adam and Eve resulted in the threefold lust or concupiscence. In his epistle, St. John the Evangelist said, *"For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the pride of life, is not of the Father but is of the world"* (1 Jn 2:16). Lust or concupiscence is not of God since creation, from the beginning is good. Here is St. John Paul II:

What bears fruit in the threefold concupiscence is not the *"world"* created by God for man, whose underlying *"goodness"* we read about several times in Genesis 1: *"God saw that it was good...that it was very good."* In the threefold concupiscence, what bears fruit, by contrast, is the breaking of the first covenant with the Creator, God-Elohim. This covenant was broken in man's heart.

The human heart is made for God. It is he who satisfies all human desires and needs. That's why St. Augustine said in his Confession, *"You have made us for Yourself O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in You."* Sin alienated the human heart from God creating a vacuum and an insatiable desire. To satisfy their desire, they lust over their bodies, covet all kinds of material things and these behaviors in turn, lead to what has been called *"the pride of life."* Thus, that which supposed to be a medium of holy communion between man and woman, became an object of lustful satisfaction, an object of exploitation and/or a weapon of abuse. Yet, study has shown that *"man is insatiable by nature."* For nothing but God alone can fill the vacuum created by the heart's severance from the Creator. And so, to finally understand the mystery, the beauty, and the purpose of the human body, we must now turn to God. Next week we shall do that as we conclude this reflection.

Teología del cuerpo

Parte 4: La triple Codicia y la insaciabilidad del corazón del hombre

Sin duda, el cuerpo humano guarda los secretos de los misterios del cielo y la divinidad. Todo lo que es verdadero, bueno, bello y perfecto está divinamente programado en el cuerpo humano. Tiene el poder de transmitir y perpetuar la vida en la tierra. Es el sustrato de la comunión entre el hombre y la mujer. Pero, como hemos visto en las reflexiones anteriores, algo salió muy mal, desbaratando el plan de Dios *"desde el principio"* (Gn 2, 24-25; Mt 19, 8). A pesar de los problemas mencionados anteriormente, todavía existe un problema persistente de codicia o concupiscencia. ¿Por qué estamos plagados de problemas relacionados con la sexualidad: pensamientos lujuriosos, adicciones al sexo, pornografía y violación, abuso sexual, explotación y perversión, y falta de autocontrol? ¿Por qué la objetivación del cuerpo humano? ¿Cómo se convirtió la bendición de Dios en una maldición?

La Triple Codicia o Concupiscencia

Según las Escrituras y los Padres de la Iglesia, el pecado original de Adán y Eva resultó en la triple codicia o concupiscencia. En su carta, San Juan Evangelista dijo: *"Pues toda la corriente del mundo, la codicia del hombre carnal, los ojos siempre ávidos, y la arrogancia de los ricos, nada viene del Padre, sino del mundo."* (1 Jn 2, 16). La codicia o concupiscencia no es de Dios desde la creación, desde el principio es buena. Aquí está San Juan Pablo II:

Lo que da fruto en la triple concupiscencia no es el *"mundo"* creado por Dios para el hombre, cuya principal *"bondad"* leemos varias veces en el Génesis 1: *"Dios vio que era bueno... que era muy bueno"*. En la triple concupiscencia, lo que da fruto, por el contrario, es la ruptura del primer pacto con el Creador, Dios-Elohim. Este pacto se rompió en el corazón del hombre.

El corazón humano está hecho para Dios. Es él quien satisface todos los deseos y necesidades humanas. Por eso San Agustín dijo en su confesión, *"Nos has hecho para ti, Señor, y nuestros corazones están inquietos hasta que descansen en ti"*. El pecado alejó el corazón humano de Dios creando un vacío y un deseo insaciable. Para satisfacer su deseo, codician sus cuerpos, codician todo tipo de cosas materiales y estos comportamientos a su vez, conducen a lo que se ha llamado *"el orgullo de la vida"*. Así, lo que suponía ser un medio de santa comunión entre el hombre y la mujer, se convirtió en un objeto de satisfacción lujuriosa, un objeto de explotación y/o un arma de abuso. Sin embargo, el estudio ha demostrado que *"el hombre es insaciable por naturaleza"*. Porque sólo Dios puede llenar el vacío creado por la separación del corazón del Creador. Y así, para entender finalmente el misterio, la belleza y el propósito del cuerpo humano, debemos ahora volvernos a Dios. La próxima semana lo haremos al concluir esta reflexión.

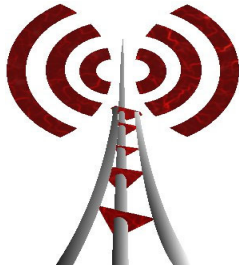

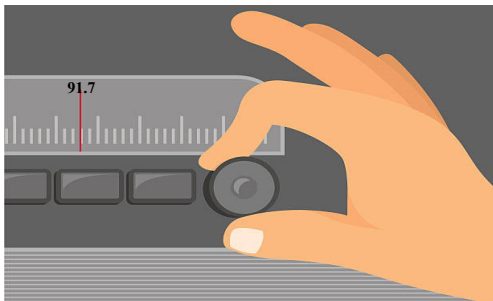

DIRECTION

Isaiah tells us something that we already know, and yet seem to forget every now and then. He tells us, essentially, that God is God and we are not. When we're confused and troubled and can't figure everything out, it might be wise to recall Isaiah speaking on the Lord's behalf and explaining that God—who is on a much more, well, Godly wavelength than we are—moves in ways we can't even imagine.

Saint Paul, by comparison, has everything figured out. Kind of. At least he understands his calling in life—to magnify Christ in everything he does. That should give all of us the direction we need. Jesus gives us direction, too, explaining to us once again in the parable of the workers in the vineyard that the last will be first, and the first, last.

DIRECCIÓN

Isaías nos dice algo que ya sabemos, pero que parecemos olvidar de tanto en tanto. Nos dice, en esencia, que Dios es Dios y nosotros no lo somos. Cuando estamos confundidos, llenos de problemas y no podemos solucionarlo todo, tal vez sea sabio recordar a Isaías (alguien que está más en la sintonía divina que nosotros) hablando en nombre del Señor y explicando que Dios se mueve de maneras que ni siquiera podemos imaginar.

En comparación, san Pablo lo ha resuelto todo. Casi todo. Cuando menos entiende su llamado en esta vida: dar gloria a Cristo en todo lo que hace. Esto debería marcar el rumbo para nosotros. Jesús también nos marca el camino, explicándonos una vez más en la parábola de los viñadores que los últimos serán los primeros, y que los primeros serán los últimos.

While the school may have installed basic content filtering software and limited access protections, parents should review the device protections before letting children use them. Jesus concluded the parable:
