Below is a chapter summary from the *New Catholic Answer Bible*, published by *Our Sunday Visitor*, on the Sacrament of Penance (also known as Confession or Reconciliation)

Why Do Catholics Confess to a Priest? Shouldn't Each Person Confess Directly to God?

The first two chapters of the Old Testament book of Baruch tell us how the Jewish leaders in ancient Babylon where humiliated by their enemies. These penitents confessed their sins to God and to the priests back in Jerusalem, asking the priest to intercede for them: "Pray for us to the Lord, our God, for we have sinned against the Lord, our God" (*Baruch* 1:13).

Thus, the practice of confessing sins to God as represented by a priest, and having the priest respond with a prayer for divine mercy, is part of the practice of God's people (see also *Leviticus* 19:20-22). In the Catholic practice, however, the priest not only prays for the penitent but also imposes a penance (satisfaction) and speaks on God's behalf the words of forgiveness (absolution).

This sacrament of Penance or Reconciliation, as it is called, is firmly grounded both in Scripture Tradition. The priestly authority to represent God as an ambassador of His mercy was granted by Jesus to St. Peter and the other apostles – and by extension, to the priests they and their successors ordained: "Whatever you bind [that is, by imposing penance] on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose [that is, forgive in God's name] on earth shall be loosed in heaven (*Matthew* 16:19; 19:18) and whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." (*John* 20:23).

In the early Church, confession of grace sin was often made to the whole Christian assembly as well as the priests. Certain instructions in the Letter of James are suggestive of this early practice. When sick, believers were to call in the Presbyters (priests). The priests were then to anoint them with oil and pray for them. In confessing their sins, the sick could be healed and forgiven (*James* 5:13-16).

Naturally, Catholics are obligated to repent of all mortal, or grave, sins (contrition) and to confess them to a priest in order to be absolved. The penitent then performs the assigned penance to repair the harm caused by the sin. The absolution given by the priest is not a merely an expression of hope for forgiveness, but a sacrament as well.

A continuación se muestra un resumen del capítulo de la Nueva Biblia Católica de Respuestas, publicado por *Our Sunday Visitor*, sobre el Sacramento de la Penitencia (también conocido como Confesión o Reconciliación)

¿Por qué los católicos se confiesan con un sacerdote? ¿No debería cada persona confesarse directamente con Dios?

Los dos primeros capítulos del libro de Baruc del Antiguo Testamento nos cuentan cómo los líderes judíos en la antigua Babilonia fueron humillados por sus enemigos. Estos penitentes confesaron sus pecados a Dios y a los sacerdotes en Jerusalén, pidiéndole al sacerdote que intercediera por ellos: "Ruega por nosotros al Señor, nuestro Dios, porque hemos pecado contra el Señor, nuestro Dios" (*Baruc* 1:13).

Por lo tanto, la práctica de confesar los pecados a Dios, representada por un sacerdote, y hacer que el sacerdote responda con una oración por la misericordia divina, es parte de la práctica del pueblo de Dios (*Levítico* 19:20-22). En la práctica católica, sin embargo, el sacerdote no sólo reza por el penitente, sino que también impone una penitencia (satisfacción) y pronuncia en nombre de Dios las palabras de perdón (absolución) "...in el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo."

Este sacramento de la Penitencia, Confesión o Reconciliación, como se llama, está firmemente fundamentado en la Tradición Bíblica. La autoridad sacerdotal de representar a Dios como embajador de su misericordia fue concedida por Jesús a San Pedro y a los demás apóstoles y, por extensión, a los sacerdotes que ellos y sus sucesores ordenaron: "Todo lo que atéis [es decir, imponiendo penitencia] en la tierra será vínculo en el cielo; y todo lo que desatares [es decir, perdonar en el nombre de Dios] en la tierra será desatado en el cielo (*Mateo* 16:19; 19:18) y a quienes perdonéis los pecados les serán perdonados, ya quienes se los retengáis les serán retenidos." (*Juan* 20:23).

En la Iglesia primitiva, la confesión del pecado por gracia a menudo se hacía a toda la asamblea cristiana, así como a los sacerdotes. Ciertas instrucciones en la Carta de Santiago sugieren esta práctica temprana. Cuando estaban enfermos, los creyentes debían llamar a los presbíteros (sacerdotes). Los sacerdotes debían entonces ungirlos con aceite y orar por ellos. Al confesar sus pecados, los enfermos podían ser sanados y perdonados (*Santiago* 5:13-16).

Naturalmente, los católicos están obligados a arrepentirse de todos los pecados mortales o graves (contrición) y confesarlos a un sacerdote para ser absueltos. El penitente luego realiza la penitencia asignada para reparar el daño causado por el pecado. La absolución dada por el sacerdote no es simplemente una expresión de esperanza en el perdón, sino también un sacramento.

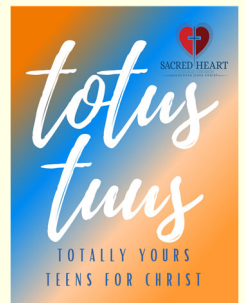
