

BAPTISMS

Wielu nawet gorliwych katolików skarży się" że nie odczuwa żadnej miłości do Boga. Tak mówiąc, zapominamy, że miłość Boża nie leży w sferze uczuć i porządku naturalne-go. Miłość Boża jest łaską podobną do wiary, o którą modlić się trzeba. Uczucia lub ich brak nie stanowią o naszej miłości do Boga. O tym, czy kochamy Boga decyduje nasz stosunek do przykazań. Jeżeli je zachowujemy, to mamy miłość do Boga, jeżeli nie to chociażby serce nasze zalewało uczucie - trudno by było mówić o tym, iż kochamy Boga. A zatem, jeżeli żyjemy według przykazań Bożych, to na pewno Jego miłość jest w nas. Z drugiej jednak strony, gdy nasze życie religijne będzie pulsowało i będziemy coraz wierniejsi Bogu, mogą pojawić się uczucia. Są one wtedy darem Bożym i trzeba za nie dziękować Bogu. Tego rodzaju uczucia bywają czasem pomocne w prowadzeniu życia religijnego, ale nie należy do nich przywiązywać wagi zbyt wielkiej.

Re: The Solemnity of the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ

Thursday, May 21st, is the Feast of the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ. This day is a Solemnity (Solemn Holy Day) and a day of Obligation. All five (5) Bishops of New Jersey dioceses have met on this topic and agreed to move this high holy day from Thursday, May 21st, to be celebrated on Sunday, May 24th, replacing the Seventh Sunday of Easter. Hence, Thursday, Friday and Saturday of the Sixth Week of Easter are to be celebrated as such and in accord with the prescriptions of the Roman Missal and the Lectionary.

Please note, that this transfer is for this liturgical year only and was made to ease the burden on those who are required to live-stream Masses and in the light of the dispensations already provided in all five (5) dioceses from the obligation of the faithful to participate in Mass on Sunday and Holy Days.

I strongly encourage you to observe and celebrate this holy day of the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ to Heaven by offering extra prayers and novenas and participate in the live-streaming of the Holy Mass, thus reminding ourselves that He who has ascended to Heaven from whence He came, will return in glory not only to judge the living and the dead but to bring all those who love Him to the glory promised on the day of their Baptism. So let us give praise and worship to our God who is faithful and true and who loves us. By our worship of Christ's Ascension we enter into the mysteries of Christ's life for our benefit and everlasting happiness. Praised be Our Lord Jesus Christ!
