

SACRAMENT OF HOLY MATRIMONY / WEDDINGS

Arrangements are to be made by calling the Parish Office no less than **ONE YEAR** in advance. Absolutely **NO** social plans are to be made before meeting with the parish Priest or Deacon. Please note: Sacrament of Holy Matrimony will be celebrated on **1st** and **3rd** Saturdays @ 1:00pm only.

Weddings are reserved for registered parishioners and their family members. **NO** Sunday weddings (nuptials) will be scheduled.

BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated on the **2nd** & **4th** Saturday at 1:00pm with the exception of Holy Days. **Pre-Baptism class**, will be at 11:00 am every 3rd Saturday of the month in Church. Parents and Godparents must attend.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS (RCIA)

The RCIA is the process the Church uses to form and inform those who want to "inquire" about the Catholic faith. This process is for those who have never been baptized, baptized adults needing Confirmation and Holy Eucharist, and those of other faiths who feel called to become Catholic. Is God calling you?
