

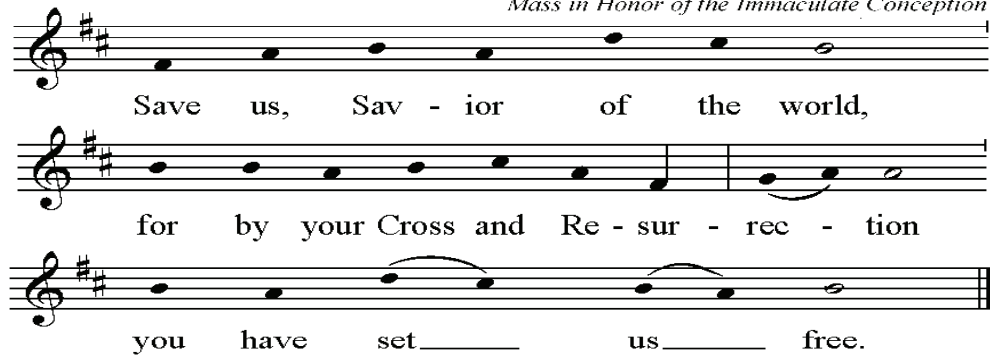
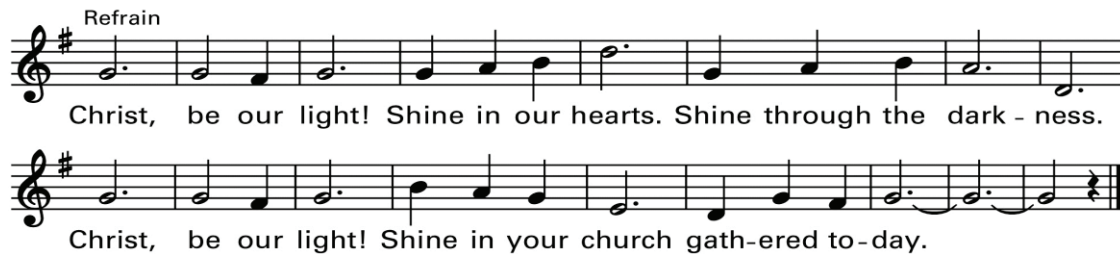

BY THE WAY . . .

- Because the traditional **Solemnity of Saint Joseph** falls this year on the Fourth Sunday of Lent, the Solemnity is transferred to Monday, March 20. Saint Joseph is the patron saint of the Universal Church, patron of workers and carpenters, and of a happy death, of six parishes in our diocese, including the oldest in the state at West Milford, and of Saint Joseph's Hospital and Saint Joseph's Home of the Little Sisters of the Poor.

It is the custom today, especially among Italians, to bless bread, pastries and other food on a "Saint Joseph's Table." Depending on the circumstances, some of the food is reserved for the poor, or some of the pastries are raffled off to raise money for the feeding of the poor. The Neapolitans, in particular, practice the custom of *caffè sospeso*, (coffee in advance) which means paying for two cups of coffee so that the proprietor can later give a free cup of coffee to a poor person. The Neapolitans also do this with a slice of pizza. You would think that as prices have gone up, the people of Naples would be backing away from this custom. But, it has actually grown in the last two years as the Neapolitans have become more conscious of the marginalizing of the poor.

It offers us some good ideas for our own Lenten almsgiving that honors Saint Joseph.

- I received a check this past week from the Paterson Diocese for \$14,886 representing the first installment of the rebate due us from the **Diocesan Ministries Appeal** which took place last Fall. Our parish goal in the Appeal was \$39,843. Nearly 300 families and individuals from our parish participated generously, and so far we have raised \$69,615. The check represents half of the total received over the goal. Thank you to all who responded so generously.
- The Paterson Diocese is sponsoring a **Men's Lenten Evening of Prayer** on March 24 at 6:00 P.M. More information may be obtained from the website for Saint Paul's Inside the Walls at www.insidethewalls.com.
- The fourth presentation of Father Ray's series on **The Sacraments** will take place this Wednesday evening at 7:30 P.M. in the church. The topic for this week will be the theology, history, and present practice of **Penance**.
Father Frank will continue his series on Pope Benedict XVI's encyclical, "God is Love," on Tuesday evening at 7:30 P.M. in the church.

Gospel: John 9:1-41

Jesus performs the miracle of giving sight to the man born blind. Because Jesus performed this miracle on the Sabbath, the Pharisees called him a "sinner," but the blind man said, "He is a prophet." Jesus later reveals to the blind man that He is the Son of Man.
