BY THE WAY . . .

As we draw closer to **Holy Week and the Paschal Triduum**, below is the schedule of liturgies for this sacred time.

--- the last scheduled opportunities for **Confessions** are on Monday, March 27 from 7:00 to 8:30 P.M.; and on Saturday, April 1, from 4:30 to 5:15 P.M. There are no Confessions scheduled on Monday, April 3 (because of the Chrism Mass) nor on Holy Saturday, April 8;

--- **Palm Sunday** follows the regular Sunday schedule;

--- **Holy Thursday**, April 6, the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper is at 7:30 P.M., followed by Adoration at the Repository until Midnight; Night Prayer will be said at 11:45 P.M.; there is no morning Mass on Holy Thursday;

--- **Good Friday**, April 7, the Liturgy of the Lord's Passion and Death will be at 3:00 P.M.; the Tenebrae Prayer Service will be celebrated in the evening at 7:30 P.M.; Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence;

--- **Holy Saturday**, April 8, the Easter Vigil Mass will begin outside church at 8:00 P.M.; the Eastern European Blessing of Easter Foods will take place at 2:00 P.M.; on Holy Saturday there is no morning Mass, no Confessions, and no 5:30 P.M. Mass;

--- **Easter Sunday**, April 9, the regular Sunday Mass schedule will be observed.

As we draw closer to the celebration of the **Easter Sacraments** please keep in your prayers those who have been preparing, through the R.C.I.A. program, to receive these sacraments. Jackelin Joa and Raul Arias will be baptized, confirmed and receive First Eucharist; Mallorie Gilbride and Dina Lind will make a Profession of the Catholic Faith and be confirmed and receive First Eucharist; Rosita Mendoza, Giovanna Marroquin, Alberto Irizarry, Jr., Daniel Martinez, and Roger Garay will be confirmed.

- Father Frank will continue his series on Pope Benedict XVI's encyclical, **God is Love** on Tuesday evening at 7:30 P.M.

Father Ray will continue his series on the Seven Sacraments, with a presentation on **Anointing of the Sick** on Wednesday at 7:30 P.M.

- I received a check this past week from the Paterson Diocese for \$14,886 representing the first installment of the rebate due us from the **Diocesan Ministries Appeal** which took place last Fall. Our parish goal in the Appeal was \$39,843. Nearly 300 families and individuals from our parish participated generously, and so far we have raised \$69,615. The check represents half of the total received over the goal. Thank you to all who responded so generously.

- Congratulations to **Sister Colleen Clare, F.M.A.**, former principal of Saint Anthony's School (2018-2021), and current principal of Mary Help of Christians Academy in North Haledon. Last Sunday morning Sister Colleen was announced as the new **Provincial Superior** for the Salesian Sisters in the Eastern U.S.A./Canada Province of Saint Joseph. Sister Colleen succeeds Sister Joanne Holloman, F.M.A., another former principal of Saint Anthony's School, who had served as provincial for the past six years.

- Please remember in your prayers **Father Daniel A. Kelly** (1950-2023) former pastor of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, Wayne who died on March 16 after a battle of several years with multiple cancers. He has helped us out here multiple times with Masses and Penance. Father Dan and I go back so far that we rode on the same school bus in grammar school. May he rise in glory!
- Saturday, March 25 is the **Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord**, a feast which, appearing nine months before the Nativity, is tied into the Christmas cycle. It is one of the two or three days each Lent when the somber violet of the season, gives way to white vestments.

- This coming May 26, the Feast of Saint Philip Neri, I will observe my **50th Anniversary** as a priest. Father Dan Murphy, who usually helps us on weekends, will also be among those celebrating 50 years on that day. While my actual anniversary is the Friday of Memorial Day Weekend, I have chosen to celebrate it on **June 11, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi** at the 12:00 Noon Mass, followed by a reception in our auditorium.

In those fifty years God has blessed me with some wonderful assignments, not the least of which has been my twelve years at Saint Anthony's. I am happy to invite you, if you are able, to come celebrate with me on that day. A formal invitation and response form is located elsewhere in this bulletin.

The Stations of the Cross



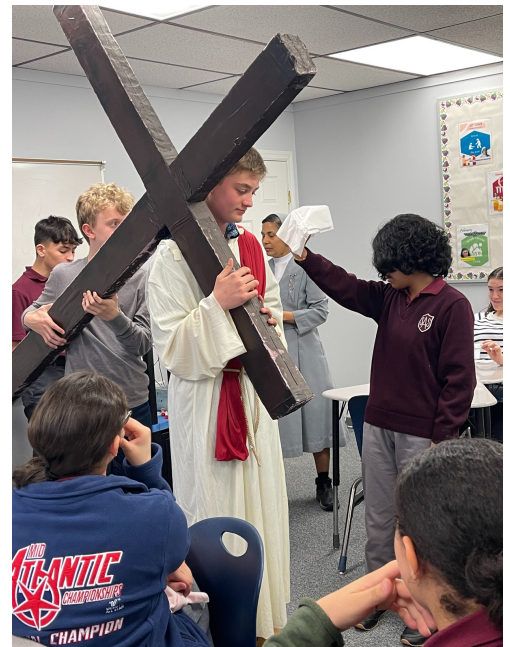

FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

“Thus says the Lord God: O my people, I will open your graves and have you rise from them, and bring you back to the land of Israel. Then you shall know that I am the Lord... O my people! I will put my spirit in you that you may live, and I will settle you upon the land; thus you shall know that I am the Lord. I have promised, and I will do it, says the Lord.”

Lent offers us the opportunity to consider the death of the Lord, but also the glory of new life, the resurrection.
