

FOOD PANTRY UPDATE

With food prices continuing to rise, our parish pantry sees very heavy activity. Our shelves need to be restocked and we are again appealing to you for assistance. At this time we especially need pasta, Parmalat or similar shelf-stable milk (whole & 2%), cereal (low sugar), hot cereal such as oatmeal, canned chicken, canned stew, tuna in water, Hamburger Helper, Suddenly Salad, pancake mix & syrup, canned fruit in 100% juice, jelly, rice & rice mixes (small boxes/packages only), juice, coffee & tea, cake mix & icing, brownie mix, granola bars, paper products (toilet tissue, napkins, facial tissue, paper plates). Food donations may be placed in the baskets on the right in the front (main) vestibule of the church as you enter or dropped off at the rectory during regular business hours. We also welcome the donation of ShopRite gift cards. If you'd like to write a check, please make it payable to St. Anthony's with "food pantry" on the memo line. Checks/gift cards in a sealed envelope addressed to "Social Services Food Pantry" may be dropped in the collection basket or dropped off at or mailed to the rectory. We are very grateful for your continued support in helping our Ministry assist our neighbors in need.



The second grade class used their knowledge of the properties of solids (absorbant, flexibile, soft, hard, reflective) to create a sun hat while stranded on a deserted island.











EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD

"And it happened that, while he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that their eyes were opened and they recognized him, but he vanished from their sight. Then they said to each other, 'Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the scriptures to us?'"

How many different sources from the scriptures there are telling us of the resurrection and appearances of the Risen Lord. From the empty tomb, the visit to the upper room, or breakfast at the sea of Galilee, all reflect the personal experience and witness. The walk on the road to Emmaus is a summary of our own experience. Does the scriptures not 'burn within us?' Are we able to recognize the presence of the Lord in our own lives, especially in the Eucharist? When I attend mass do the words, taking the bread, breaking, blessing, and giving, reveal once again the real presence of Christ?

On Easter morning Mary Magdalene went to the tomb and found it empty. She hurried to get Peter and John. Peter entered first, and when John entered he "saw and believed."



The Paschal or Easter Candle




Each year at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday, a new fire is built and blessed. From this fire, a new Paschal Candle is lit for the first time and will be used for one year. Candle designs vary, but they are always white, the largest in the worship space and contain certain symbols - a cross, the Alpha and Omega and the date. Let's design our own candle by choosing, coloring and gluing on the designs you like. Do you see the Paschal Candle in your church?

- (1) THE CROSS Always the central symbol
- (2) **THE ALPHA AND OMEGA** Tells us God is the beginning and the end
- (3) **THE CURRENT YEAR** Says God is with us here and now
- (4) **THE FLAME** Reminds us Jesus is the Light of the World
- (5) Use **RED** to make 5 points on the cross to represent the 5 wounds of Jesus


