FOOD PANTRY UPDATE



With food prices continuing to rise, our parish pantry sees very heavy activity. Our shelves need to be restocked and we are again appealing to you for assistance. At this time we especially need pasta, Parmalat or similar shelf-stable milk (whole & 2%), cereal (low sugar), hot cereal such as oatmeal, canned chicken, canned stew, tuna in water, Hamburger Helper, Suddenly Salad, pancake mix & syrup, canned fruit in 100% juice, jelly, rice & rice mixes (small boxes/packages only), juice, coffee & tea, cake mix & icing, brownie mix, granola bars, paper products (toilet tissue, napkins, facial tissue, paper plates). Food donations may be placed in the baskets on the right in the front (main) vestibule of the church as you enter or dropped off at the rectory during regular business hours. We also welcome the donation of ShopRite gift cards. If you'd like to write a check, please make it payable to St. Anthony's with "food pantry" on the memo line. Checks/gift cards in a sealed envelope addressed to "Social Services Food Pantry" may be dropped in the collection basket or dropped off at or mailed to the rectory.
