BY THE WAY . . .

- During Easter Week I received an email from Bob Zanotti, a radio journalist at Swiss Radio International in Biglen, Switzerland. He is 77 years old and was raised in Hawthorne in the 50s and 60s, and is a graduate of Saint Anthony's School. He commented on the "moving experience" of joining us for **Easter Sunday Mass** via livestream. He complimented the livestream team for their good work and looks forward to joining us again in the future.

Bob is actually one of more than 750 people who joined us for the liturgies of the Pascal Triduum this year via livestream. A big thank you to Tom Hauer and all the live streamers who make this a possibility for so many people. We've come a long way from Sister Elfie's I-Phone just three years ago!

- I was contacted recently by Bishop Sweeney's Office and asked if Saint Anthony's would once again be willing to host a Deacon Intern for the summer. So, for six weeks this summer we will be joined by **Deacon Joseph S. DeMarzo**. Joe is a twenty-nine-year-old native of Corpus Christi Parish in Chatham Township and has had previous summer assignments in Chester and Randolph. Joe is the latest in a long line of newly-ordained deacons and priests (stretching back to 1941) who have begun their careers at Saint Anthony's. We look forward to welcoming Deacon DeMarzo in a few weeks – especially since he will be here just in time to help with The Feast!

- A sure sign of the approach of Summer is the beginning, this past Tuesday, of the nine week **Novena in honor of Saint Anthony**. These Novena Prayers in honor of our parish patron saint, Anthony of Padua (died 1231) are prayed in church every Tuesday evening at 7:30 P.M. for nine consecutive Tuesdays leading up to his feast day, June 13. This year we hit the double-whammy: the last of the nine Tuesdays actually falls on Saint Anthony's Feast Day itself; and is the day before the first night of The Feast which is celebrated in his honor. Come out on these Tuesdays and offer praise to God through his powerful saint, Anthony of Padua, finder of lost things and provider of good weather for feasts!

- **Parish Demographics:** Last weekend we had six funerals at Saint Anthony's in just one weekend! It could easily lead some to think that the parish is hemorrhaging at a fast rate. But, actually I think the opposite is taking place. Both Father Frank and I, as well as several others, have commented on the increased attendance since Christmas. One of the ushers commented that he knows that a number of people at the 5:30 P.M. Saturday Mass made a New Year's Resolution to get themselves back to church! Our Holy Week liturgies were basically full.

But, even more than numbers, we seem to be adding some new people – especially at the 12:00 Noon Mass. It seems to be a mix of young singles, new young families, and older single adults coming into town. We even have baby strollers at some Masses!

Perhaps the surest sign of "new people" is the recent requests for the location of the **Stewardship Prayer** that we pray at the conclusion of the General Intercessions. It cannot be found anywhere in any collection of prayers because it is a purely homegrown Saint Anthony's Parish Prayer. It was written some fifteen years ago, primarily by the late Ann Hughes, as a project of the Stewardship Committee working at the time to urge parishioners to use their

“time, talent and treasure,” more generously in the service of the Lord. It is a beautiful prayer, and serves to almost “consecrate” the collected offerings at each Mass. Occasionally I will forget to add it and sit down, but that does not last too long because the altar servers will not budge until I get back up and lead the prayer. (Conversely, I recently gave a Lenten Mission at Saint Paul’s Parish in Princeton which included saying one of their Sunday Masses. I began praying the Stewardship Prayer and they just looked at me!

So, by popular request – and inquisitive demand - here it is, the Stewardship Prayer – the one makes you a true part of Saint Anthony’s. Welcome.

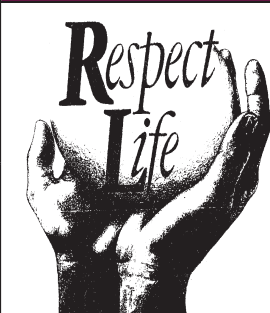
