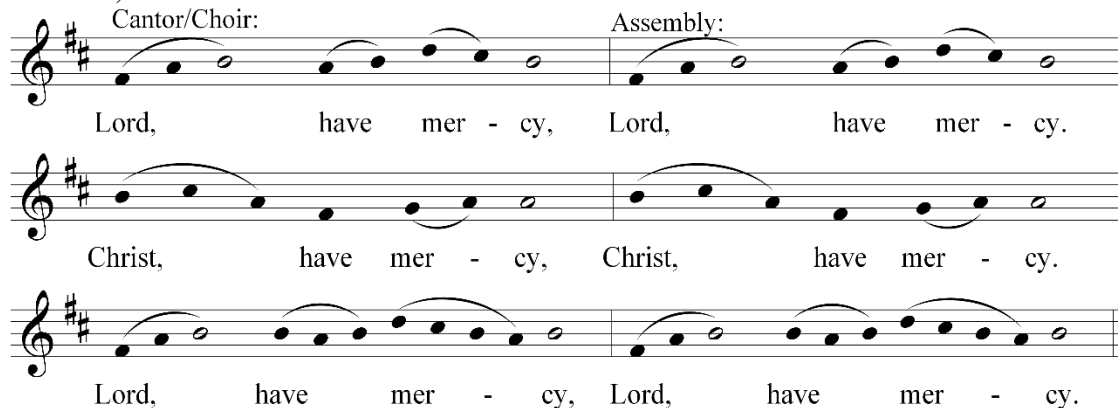





BY THE WAY . . .

- Today is often referred to as **Good Shepherd Sunday** because of the Gospel readings for the Fourth Sunday of Easter. With that in mind, it is also **World Day of Prayer for Vocations**. This is an opportunity for all of us to pray for an increased response to the Lord's call to follow him as priests, religious sisters and brothers, and permanent deacons.

The senior priest in Passaic County is Father Dick Rento (93) the retired Pastor of Saint Brendan's in Clifton. He often talks about his own vocation first being encouraged by one of his teachers in Clifton High School in the 1940s. The prayer and encouragement we offer our young people are important keys in bringing religious vocations to the surface.

To help our young men who might be mulling over the possibility of a priestly vocation, the Paterson Diocese offers two possibilities:

The annual **Quo Vadis Retreat** which is open to young men of high school age, will be held this year on June 29, from 9:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. at Camp Shiloh in Hewitt. Signup and additional information is available at the diocesan vocations website <https://Patersonvocations.org>.

In addition, the Diocese hosts a discernment group which meets each First Saturday of the month at 10:00 A.M. at Saint Paul Inside the Walls in Madison, and is open to young men fifteen years of age and older.

- This coming Saturday, we will have the first two sessions for the **Sacrament of First Holy Communion** for a group of the young people of our parish. Please keep them and their families in your prayers over the coming week.
- The **Saint Joseph's Men**, a prayer and reflection group open to all the men of the parish, will meet this Saturday, May 6, at 8:30 A.M. in the church. This hour-long meeting occurs on the first Saturday of each month.
- As I was writing this on Tuesday morning, our Holy Father, Pope Francis appointed **Monsignor Geno Sylva**, the Rector of our Cathedral in Paterson, and diocesan Vicar for Special Projects, as a member of the Roman Dicastery for Evangelization, First Section for Fundamental Questions about Evangelization in the World. This is the Vatican department that deals with evangelization and missionary work throughout the world. It will allow Monsignor Sylva to continue his interest and efforts in the area of evangelization which he began during his five years working at the Holy See.

As we all know, Monsignor Sylva began his priestly career as parochial vicar here at Saint Anthony's in 1993. Congratulations!

- **Prayer for Vocations:**

Heavenly Father, your divine Son taught us to pray to the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into His vineyard.

We earnestly beg you to bless our diocese and our world with many priests and religious men and women who will love you fervently, and gladly and courageously spend their lives in service to Your Son's Church under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

We pray that their lives may always be centered on our Eucharistic Lord; that be always faithful to the Holy Father; and that they be devoted sons and daughters of Mary, our Mother, in making you known and loved; and that all may attain heaven.

Bless our families and our children and choose from our homes those whom you desire for this holy work.

We ask this in Jesus' name. Amen.

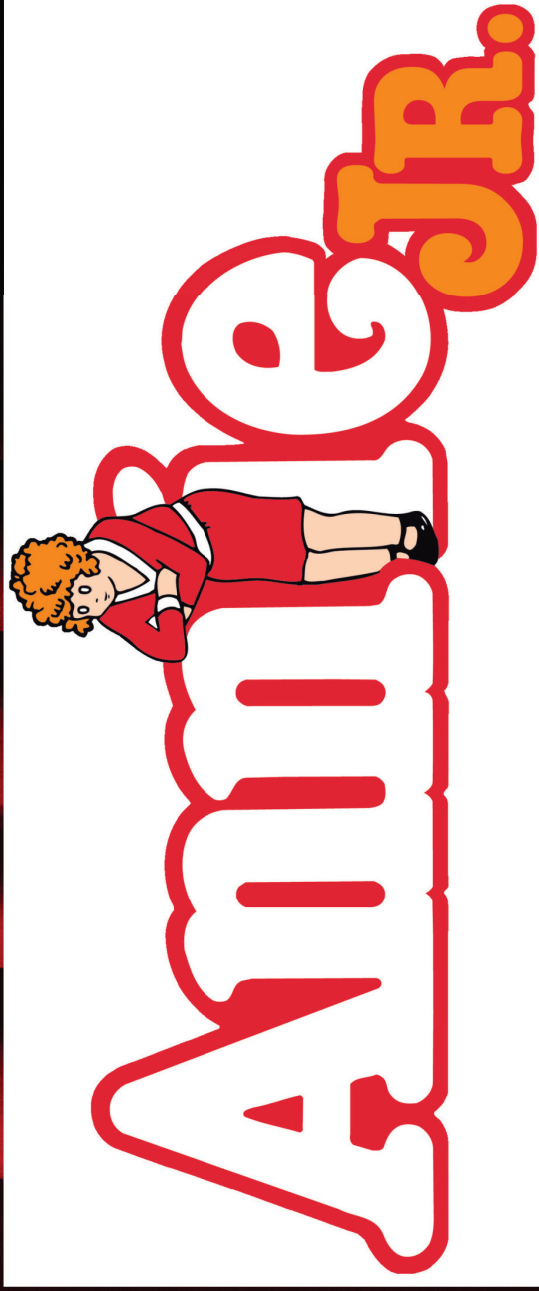

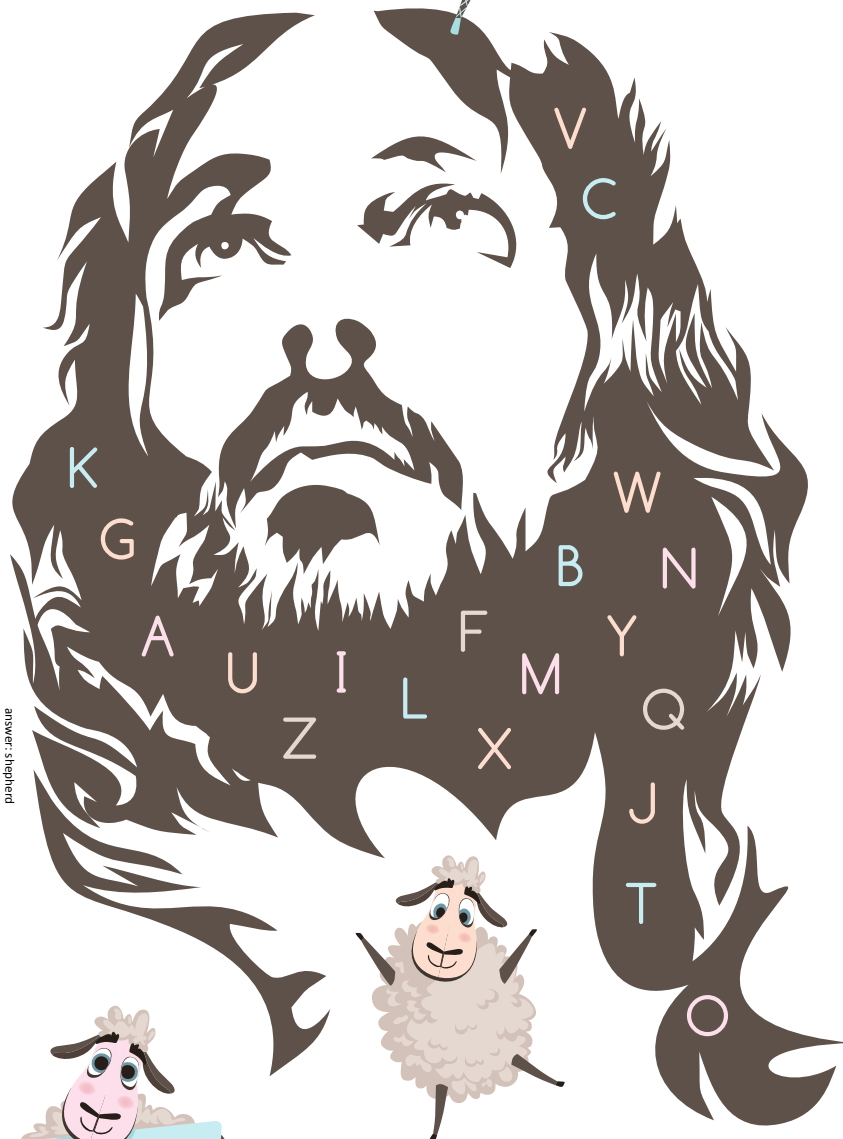

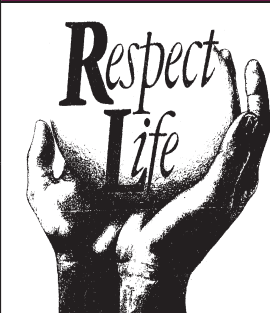
