

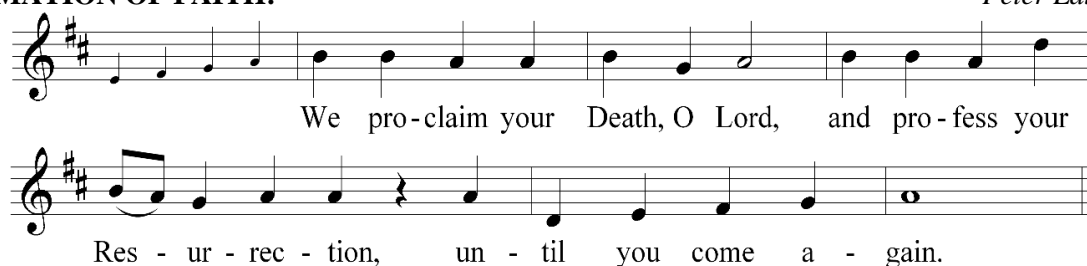

BY THE WAY . . .

- Today we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord**. Previously this feast was celebrated on a Thursday, forty days after Easter. The Bishops of New Jersey voted last year to join most of the rest of the country by moving this feast to the following Sunday, thereby removing it from the list of Holydays of Obligation.
- Let me take a moment to congratulate our **sixty First Communicants** of these past two weeks, as well as their parents and families. A word of thanks also to Sister Betty Ann Martinez, F.M.A., her staff, and all the catechists who have helped these young people approach the Table of the Lord in Holy Communion this Spring. Congratulations!
- We are already well into the month of May, a **month traditionally dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary**. If you want to spend a moment honoring Mary during this month, try praying the Rosary, especially if you have not done so in a while. The Rosary has a number of advantages. First, it is Christ-centered, and invites us to join with Mary in contemplating the scenes, or “mysteries” of her Son’s life. Second, it is scriptural; all but one of the twenty mysteries appears in Scripture. Thirdly, it is time-tested; the Rosary in its present form goes back to at least the late 1400s. Fourth, it can be prayed anywhere; it does not require any particular setting. Fifth, it is structural; because of the way it is organized, it usually takes a set period of time. And finally, it is wholistic; it involves several of our senses as we finger the beads, pray the prayers, and meditate on the mysteries.
- Although I am celebrating it on June 11, this coming Friday, the Feast of Saint Philip Neri is actually the **50th anniversary of my Ordination as a priest**. People have been asking me about my memories of that event a half-century ago. My humorous memory is that then, as now, the weekend was also Memorial Day Weekend. The Federal Government chose that weekend to open the very last stretch of Interstate Route 80. Route 80 at the time ran from New York City to San Francisco except for a small unfinished stretch in New Jersey from Parsippany to Rockaway. That stretch was opened on May 25, 1973 thereby rendering incorrect all the directions to my First Mass at Saint Christopher’s Church in Parsippany that I had included in my invitations. When I looked out at the time scheduled for the First Mass to begin, there were only ten people in church. The rest were all wandering around Parsippany trying to follow my obsolete directions!
For my 50th Anniversary I have included no directions to Saint Anthony’s in the invitations. Everyone can use GPS.
- Next Sunday is the beautiful feast of **Pentecost**, celebrating the sending forth of the Holy Spirit, and the birth of the Church. The following prayer can help us prepare for that Feast.

*By your spirit of freedom,
Lord our God,
you transformed the apostles.
From being afraid, they boldly proclaimed the Kingdom;
from being imprisoned, they joyfully went out.
Pour out this same Spirit on your Church at prayer.
Grant that it may be today
a sign of new freedom,
for all the world,
in Jesus, the Christ, our Lord. Amen.*

Passaic County Dept. of Senior Services provides one hot meal Monday through Friday at the Hawthorne Senior Center (Ambulance Corps Building), 970 Goffle Rd. There is a minimal fee, and it's a friendly environment conducive to socialization. The Center also conducts various activities such as parties, trips, lectures, etc. that meet the needs of participants. The Center is open from 8:30 A.M. to 1:30 P.M. And if you need transportation: The Passaic County Paratransit Program maintains a fleet of vehicles, which provide transportation for the county's senior citizens and disabled residents in need of non-emergency rides to medical appointments, shopping centers, county-run nutrition and adult day care sites, and for the disabled residents to attend group work programs. 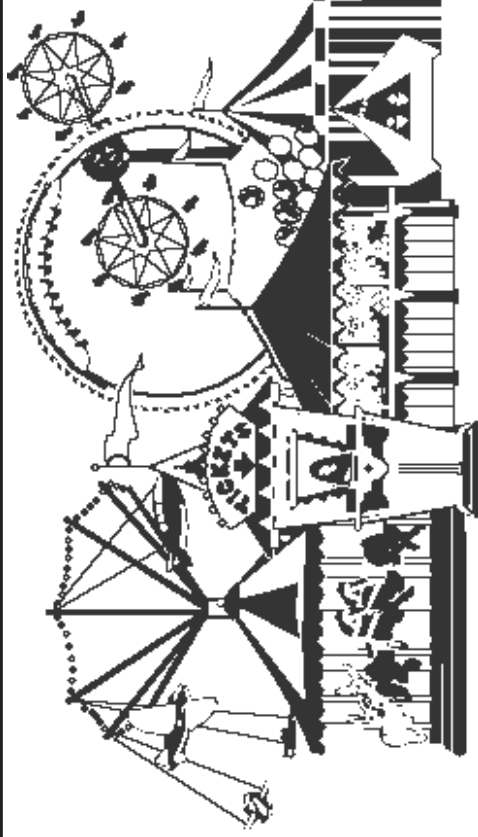

Once in the checkout you will have a choice to **email** a PDF electronic ticket to print or receive a **text** message with a QR code you can store on your mobile device. A \$2 service fee will be added for each \$30 purchase.

Please note: If you intend to make a large purchase for multiple children, it is best to separate each purchase so that you can receive different QR codes for each child's redemption at the rides.

Common Questions:

Can we use our left over paper tickets from last year? Yes, you can use them this year only.

How will you know the balance on your QR code if you use the electronic printed QR format? They can be checked at the kiosks.

How will you know the balance on your QR code if you use your mobile device? They can be checked at the kiosks.

Can any balances on QR codes for this year be used for next year? Yes

Are the QR codes specific to St. Anthony's Feast only? No, the tickets are good at any of Blue Sky Amusement events.

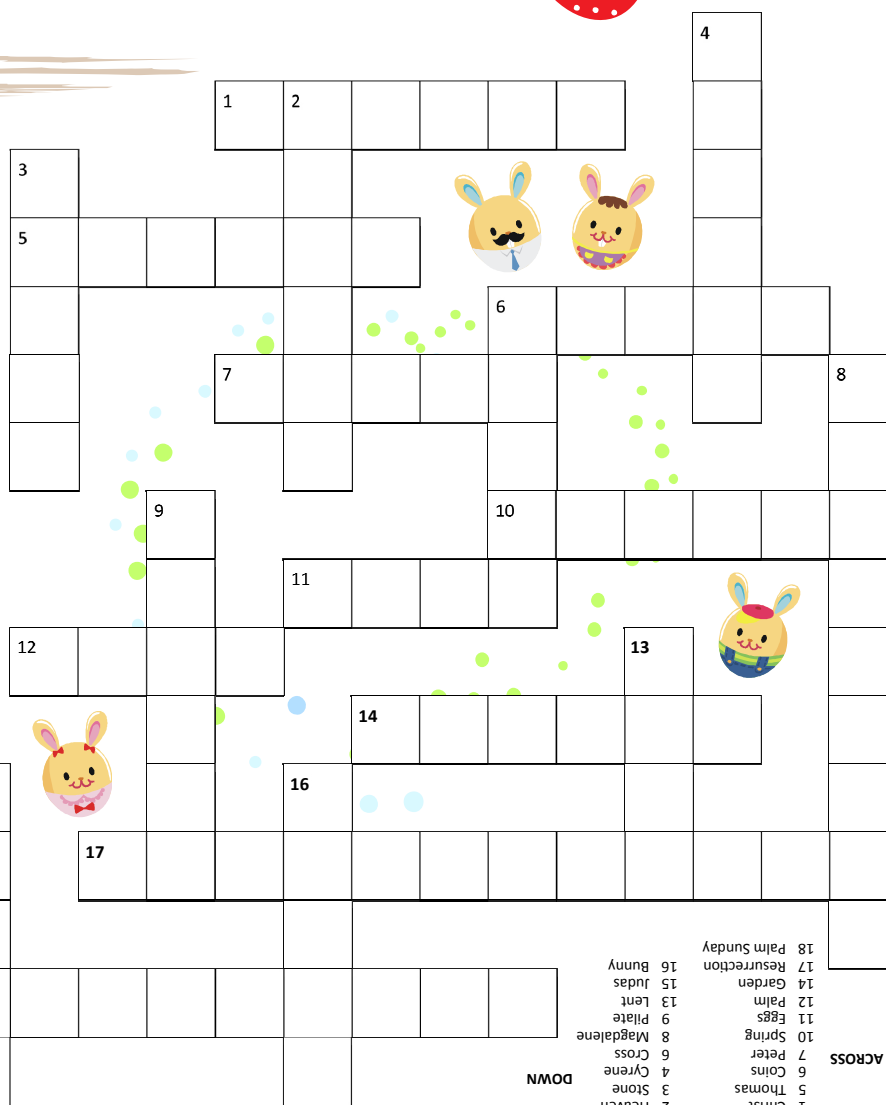

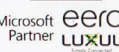
